

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parish Family,

The Prophet Isaiah speaks to us this Sunday about a carefully constructed vineyard, built with every amenity, which produces only wild grapes, not good ones. Here the focus is on the quality of the produce, but Jesus in this Sunday's Gospel changes the focus from the quality of the grapes to the quality of those called to tend and cultivate the vineyard. In the first reading the grapes are wild, but in the Gospel, the people who should be responsible have gone wild, disobedient and itching to fight.

Christian teachings are meant to penetrate

the heart of the individual, and then because the heart of convicted of the truth, behavior changes. It doesn't really ever work effectively the other way round. For centuries, people and religious leaders have been convinced that a change of heart can be brought about by being a rule follower, but it doesn't really follow.

Being obedient, being open to correction and instruction, being a rule follower, all of these things flow forth from first encountering Christ, listening to His teachings, and then allowing the human heart to be led in the ways of truth. One of the most precious gifts God has given us is free will, and we must use our free will not to please ourselves, but to please the one who created us and sustains us. The desire to please God truly pleases Him, and conversely, the desire to fight, degrade and disrespect those who come to do the Father's will provokes God's wrath and indignation.

We see in our world today many examples of the desire to fight, to degrade, and to kill. Those who are not willing to work to suppress these desires in their hearts will be left without a vineyard and left without the vintage. These are clear words from Our Lord. Jesus gives us every freedom and blessing, but we are to use these gifts carefully for the purposes of good, truth, and beauty. This is what the Apostle Paul tells us so beautifully in the second reading for this Sunday.

This past week we were so fortunate to have our bishop come to our parish and visit us, give us his blessing, and walk with us on our journey of faith. I am grateful to all who turned out so faithfully to greet him, and I am grateful to all who worked behind the scenes to make our Mass for the Archangels a sacred and beautiful moment. We continue to work faithfully in our little vineyard in East Alabama, seeking God's mercy and blessing, because without His divine aid everyday, we cannot accomplish anything on our own. Blessings to you all!
