## A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

In these fifty days of the Easter Season, we hear from the Acts of the Apostles about the Apostles and the disciples in those powerful days following the Resurrection of Jesus and awaiting the powerful coming of the Holy Spirit. These days are meant for us to learn and live profoundly what it means to be brought together into a Church.

On the first of these fifty days, our Holy Father Pope Francis was called to the house of the Eternal Father, and so we will live profoundly many realities that Jesus has given us so that we will never be lost or orphaned. We will witness the funeral of the Pope, proclaiming the faith we have as a people in the Resurrection of the Dead, and before Pentecost comes, we will see the election of the 266<sup>th</sup> successor of St. Peter the Apostle, a new Bishop of Rome.


The media coverage of these events is varied, but often, amidst all the speculations and commentary of an endless news cycle, one very important thing is forgotten: It is the Holy Spirit who moves all things, no one else, and that same Holy Spirit who came at Pentecost to breathe the Church into existence is at work in this moment as well for the salvation of all humanity, for the redemption of the whole created order in Christ.

I have often felt that one of the greatest crises of our day is how poorly the Holy Spirit and the Holy Church are understood. These are the days of the sacred calendar in which we meditate deeply on the reality of the Holy Catholic Church in our lives, how essential it is for life to be a vital member of the Church, and how living without the comfort of the Holy Spirit moving the Church and its members towards Christ is a true poverty that is the source of human misery. We must keep in mind what we learned through the Paschal Triduum: There is no human solution to human problems, only a divine solution to our fallen humanity. What a wonderful solution to seek!

Awaiting the election of the next Pope, we are in prayer together as a Church, the Mystical Body of Christ; not as random individuals gathered together in the same geographic location to make our individual prayers...living profoundly what it means to be a Church: One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic!
