We, the faith community of Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church, in striving to be like Christ, are committed to living the Gospel by participating in the Sacraments, promoting spiritual growth and religious education, and being an example of His Eucharistic love.

A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

As Christians, we are called to live profoundly the relationship of love found in the Holy Trinity. This relationship of love has another important name – Holy Communion. We read that God reached out to Moses in the Old Testament, and that movement provoked a response in the heart of Moses, and then Moses and the whole people were clothed in the sacred protection of the covenant. Even here, we see the love of the Father proceeding to Moses in the Spirit, and then we see the Son in the Word spoken and given to Moses.

God did not create the human person to be in isolation. God created the human person to be in relationship with his/her creator, and to live that relationship to its fullest. God's own being is characterized by relationship, and that is why we revere God as one in a perfect relationship of three Divine Persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This relationship is our identity and our inheritance as Christian believers. At the beginning of our lives, the priest marks us with the sign of the Holy Cross, and baptizes us in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Then, after a whole life of living with the Sign of the Cross as a constant renewing action in our lives, we come to our funeral Mass, where the priest marks us again with the powerful sign of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Yesterday, three men were ordained to the Holy Priesthood in our Cathedral in Birmingham. In a noble and holy way, they submit themselves to the Triune God to serve Him with the merits and gifts they have received from Him. St. Augustine reminds us: "When You crown their merits, You crown your own gifts." We must pray for our priests, especially the newly ordained, that they will be protected from all harm and that the life God has given them will bear much fruit for the Kingdom. Trinitarian love is meant to be the hallmark of priesthood. To be a priest of Jesus Christ means to dedicate one's whole life to professing and living the Mystery of the Trinity and the love that characterizes the union of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This is why the actions of the priest begin with the Sign of the Cross and end with the Sign of the Cross.

Our Triune God wants all of us to live fully His divine life here and now, calling out to Him, worshipping Him, even offering Him our questions and doubts. In the fullness of time, the Father sent us the Son as the visible sacrament of this relationship, and Jesus comes to us through the Blessed Virgin, who conceived of the Holy Spirit. Mary is the one who first understood perfectly this Trinitarian relationship because she experienced it in her own body and soul. The same is now true for us. When we faithfully receive the Sacred Host, the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ, we do so in worship of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, who are all present in that sacred Eucharistic action, and want to be in profound relationship with us.
