A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,


Last Sunday, we celebrated the identity of our God as a relationship – a Holy Communion of Three Divine Persons on One God. This Sunday, we celebrate the way that God has chosen to communicate His own divine life to us – through the Eucharist. The physical substances of bread and wine are transformed by the Holy Spirit and the prayers of the priest into the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ our Lord, and remain so, Our Lord Present in our midst. This sacrament is a nourishing, protecting, and strengthening sacrament for the Christian.

In the light of this mystery of faith, it is essential that we consider what this means for the Christian in our lives. In the Eucharist, we are one bread, one body in Christ. We say this, we sing this, but we struggle to live this reality. In this world, there are many opinions, ideas, ideologies, and differences. The Lord Jesus Christ comes into this world in order to give us a focus and a unity in his person so that can overcome any human divisions. That is why we must take so seriously the gift of Holy Communion and make every effort possible to live in Holy Communion every day of our lives.

Over the years, I have heard endless commentary about Catholic faith and its relationship to Holy Communion, with opinions on all sides. The truth of the matter, however, is that we live in different stages of communion at different moments of our life, but our goal is to live at the highest stage this side of heaven, which is to receive the Holy Eucharist with no division in our hearts, no hatred for others, and no mortal sins that have broken our relationship with our loving God. Our worship of the Lord God giving us His Body and Blood is the most perfect expression of our unity in being redeemed by Him, so Holy Communion should never be a casual or routine act. We should prepare with anticipation all week to make this sacred moment on Sunday the highlight and goal of all that we say, do, and think.

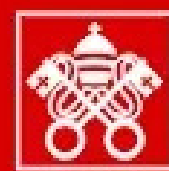
