# A Message from our Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

This year, the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul falls on a Sunday, so we are able to celebrate this great feast in the context of our community's weekly Eucharist. Our Catholic faith teaches us that Saints Peter and Paul together represent the order and evangelizing impulse that characterize our Church and that should characterize the life of every Christian.

St. Peter is the Apostle who makes a precious confession of faith that Jesus "is the Christ, the Son of the Living God." The Father reveals this truth to St. Peter in a special way so that he can lead the Apostles and thus, the Church towards all holiness and salvation. Without this clarity and order, we have simple chaos in our relationship with Christ. We see that without the saving order and structure of a Church that is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic, the work of the salvation of souls becomes diluted, dissipated, and weak.

St. Paul represents for us the zeal for proclaiming the good news all over the face of the earth. Missionary zeal, coupled with the uncompromising Truth of Jesus the Son of the Living God, and the charity that flows from the sacrifice of a crucified and resurrected Lord touches the hearts of all who are open, and give us all a pattern for our own discipleship. This proclamation is also liberating for those enslaved by the oppressions of the evil spirit.

Rooted firmly in the truth of Jesus given to the Church, we confidently can proclaim Him as the Lord who was born in Bethlehem, who lived among us, then suffered died, and rose again on the third day, and who will come again in glory. Saints Peter and Paul proclaimed this truth and shed their blood for this truth in the soil of Rome – nowhere else. 


