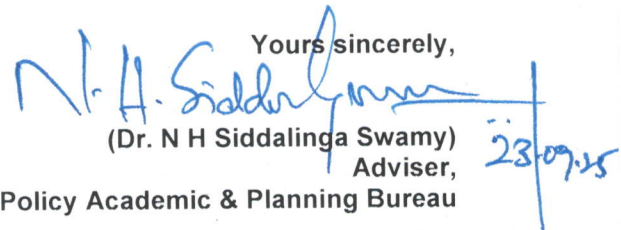
- Develop youth leadership grounded in governance knowledge, policy frameworks, and tribal heritage among all students, in all students, including ST students.
