Seven Reasons to Take the Ancient Prophecies Literally

Backed by Ancient History, Scientific Discovery and Scripture

1. Discovery of the Higgs boson particle in the Spring of 2012 - may be used to explain how the First Dominion of the Messiah was 'folded up and changed' (Hebrews 1:10-12 and Psalm 102:25-27) into an unseen realm or dimension - when Satan and his armies of dissenters came up against the 'Camp of the Saints' during the last Feast of Tabernacles for that Age. Some scientists call it the '*God particle*' while some others call it simply '*Faith*.' Hebrews 11:1: 'Faith is the *substance* of things hoped-for, and the *evidence* of things not seen.' Isaac Newton would've called it 'alchemy.'
2. The New Covenant between God and Israel - was confirmed for seven years with the dwellers at Qumran who had fled from Judean cities when the 'abomination that maketh desolate' took place in the Temple at Jerusalem [Wars of the Jews Book 2, chapter 12:1] in the year 0063. Excerpts from the 'Dead Sea Scrolls' speak about the 'Teacher of Righteousness' who appeared from time to time to those who heard Jesus' instructions and fled, grounding them in the ways of the 'New Covenant and the gospel of the kingdom.' The 'Damascus document', the 'Habakkuk Commentary' and the Commentary on Psalm 37—all refer to an anonymous 'Teacher of Righteousness.' And the Prophet Daniel corroborated this [Daniel 9:27].
3. In the midst of the last seven years, Jesus/Yhswah appeared suddenly in the Temple and had it out with the priests; sanctifying and ordaining them to minister baptism instead of offering sacrifices. See scripture by Prophet Malachi, and in Wars of the Jews Book 6, chapter 5:3 where the 'voices' were those of the 'man child' of The Revelation chapter 12—caught up to God and to His throne.
4. Both Isaiah and Micah describe the 'Mountain of the House of The Lord' being established in the tops of the mountains and exalted above the hills at Jerusalem - during the 'Last Days' of the Israelite: And for proof that Christ's disciples were living in their 'Last Days:' Hebrews 1:1-2 'God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in THESE LAST DAYS spoken unto us by His Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; Hebrews 9:27 - Jesus appeared once, in the End of the World—to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.
5. Christ told His followers that the End of their Age would come when the 'gospel of the kingdom' was preached in all the world as a witness. The Apostle Paul, before he was killed - said THE GOSPEL HAD BEEN PREACHED TO EVERY CREATURE UNDER HEAVEN. Matthew 24:14 and Colossians 1:23
6. Apostles Paul and Peter and in the New Testament book 'James' you find many references to the 'coming' of The Lord [Greek definition #G3952 (Strong's Concordance) παρουσία parousia (par-oo-see'-ah): From the present participle of G3918; a *being near*, that is, *advent* (often, *return*; specifically of Christ TO PUNISH JERUSALEM, OR FINALLY THE WICKED); (by implication) physical *aspect*: - coming, presence. Total KJV occurrences: 24. Jeremiah wrote about the coming of The Lord to punish or bring evil upon the city called by His Name, and the rest of the world at the time of the 0070 Siege of Jerusalem; leaving dead bodies lying all over the earth. And Apostle Paul wrote in his second letter to Timothy, that the Lord Jesus Christ would judge the living and the dead AT HIS APPEARING ('COMING') AND HIS KINGDOM.
7. In Hebrews chapter ten, some of the saints were close to losing their confidence in Jesus' promise of His coming. They'd heard Him say that some standing there—would not taste of death until they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom [Matthew 16:28, Mark 9:1]. The apostle told them: "...For yet a little while, and He that shall come, will come, and WILL NOT TARRY [Hebrews 10:35-37].
