"No I can't make the Bible come alive for anyone. The Bible is already alive. It makes me come alive." R.C. Sproul

The beautiful truth is that God opens our eyes, He will provide wisdom and understanding as we dive into *His* word as *His* child. The most powerful lesson I have learned has shown me just how true this quote from R.C. Sproul is; His word is alive and makes me come alive. Studying His word makes me feel more alive and closer to my great God. As Christians when we have a relationship we have a desire, a desire to dig deeper, to know more, and be in His word. If we ask God He will give us wisdom, focus and understanding. I desire to be in His word, because we trust His word. It's living and active (Hebrews 4:12), the heavens declare His work (Psalm 19:1-14), His promises are trustworthy, we can trust His covenant, and His promise (2 Samuel 7:28), and every word of God proves true (Proverbs 30:5).

As women we should be intentional in our study of His word, be in His word regularly and often. We should desire to not just read His word but to feel it, breath it, and take it all in. Psalm 119: 10-32 describes what we should desire as Christians - to seek Him with all my heart, meditate on His word, delight in His word and not neglect His word.
