One of the most interesting books in the Bible is the book of Ruth. In the first chapter we find a tragic story of backsliding and its consequences.

The story is as follows: There was a man named Elimelech and a woman named Naomi who lived in Beth-lehem-judah.

There was a famine in the land, so Naomi and Elimelech took their two boys, Mahlon and Chilion, into Moab to find food. Mahlon and Chilion married two Moabitess girls named Orpah and Ruth.

This family did not intend to stay in Moab. They went to sojourn, or to pass through, to get some food. However, they stayed for ten years.

During this time Elimelech died; Mahlon died; and Chilion died, leaving Naomi with her two daughters-in-law, Orpah and Ruth.

These three widows faced the future without their husbands. Naomi decided to return to Bethlehem.

Ruth decided to go with her. Orpah determined to stay in Moab. This is all of the story that we will discuss for this lesson from Ruth 1.
