Lesson 8  
Jesus' Summary of His Earthly Life

Last week we discussed the one-sentence biography of Jesus: "...who went about doing good." Now He is at the end of His earthly life.

He prays what is truly the Lord's prayer. We call the Lord's Prayer, "Our Father, which art in Heaven..." but that is not the Lord's prayer; it is a model prayer from which we are to pray.

The Lord's prayer is found in John 17 and is the object of our lesson for this week. In this prayer Jesus sums up what He did during His earthly ministry.

Let us notice this summary which was given to us just a few hours before His death.

This is the prayer that was prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane when He sweat drops of perspiration that were like blood.

1. THE \_\_\_\_\_ FOR WHICH HE PRAYED. (John 17.)
