September Meeting Minutes

We need a few volunteers to help set up and do the cooking as well as people to man the card stops. Hot dogs, hamburgers and brats and chili will be furnished by the club. Club members and participants are asked to bring their own drinks and a dish to share. Since the parking lot at the community college is currently under construction, Barry will determine the best place to meet at the college.

Arrangements are already under way for next year's Easter Show. The Family Area has been booked.
