Virtues, Explained!

Perseverance

“It is not easy for man, wounded by sin, to maintain moral balance,” we read in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (1811). “Christ’s gift of salvation offers us the grace necessary to persevere in the pursuit of the virtues.”

Perseverance is unique because without it, we cannot grow in any of the other virtues. If we cannot persevere, we cannot carry the cross. Faith, hope, love, mercy, justice, temperance — these virtues are the fruits of a Christian life, and perseverance is the soil in which they take root.

Like the soil in any garden, it has to be nourished. Perseverance is fed by trials, difficulties, and temptations. “We rejoice in our sufferings,” writes St. Paul, “knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us” (Romans 5:4-5). ©LPi

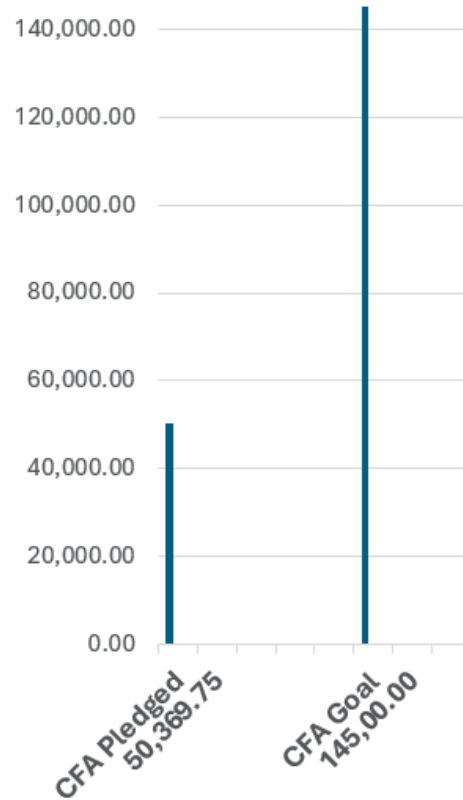
