## 2024 NASSBT TOURNAMENT RULES

## REVISED 1-1-2023

1. REQUIREMENTS - At the time of bowling you must be at least 60 years of age for males and 50 years of age for females.
2. FEES - $\boldsymbol{A} \$ 25.00$ Annual Membership Fee is due at your 1st tournament.

The cost of each regular event is $\$ 100$. August Doubles and December's Year End Tournament entry fee will be $\$ 125$. From each entry $\$ 5.00$ will be applied to the December year-end prize fund.
3. QUALIFYING FORMAT - This tournament consists of 5 games of qualifying, moving pairs of lanes after each game. Should a tie occur after 5 games of qualifying, a $9^{\text {th }} \& 10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off will determine the winner. If another tie occurs, the process will be repeated until a winner emerges.
4. SCORING CHANGES - Only by Tournament Director or Center staff member. All participants will be responsible for their own re-cap sheets. All scores must be verified by another bowler crossing on your pair of lanes; and submitting them to the tournament office. Any incorrect scores recorded on your re-cap will be subject to disqualification.
5. DRESS CODE - REQUIRED to wear a shirt with your name on the back. $1^{\text {st }}$ offense receives a warning, $2^{\text {nd }}$ offense a $\$ 10$ penalty. Dress slacks/shorts are allowed. Ladies: capris, skirts or skorts. NO JEANS; t-shirts; tank tops; hats; headbands sweats; or cut-offs.
6. EQUIPMENT - All bowling equipment must meet USBC regulations. New releases must be approved by tournament officers.
7. APPRECIATION - Show respect to each host center. Any issues with lane conditions or the center in general, will be addressed to the Tournament Director.
8. RE-RACKS - Only 2 re-racks are allowed per game, more than that requires director's approval.
9. CHECK IN -- Start at 8:30 am. Late entries will receive ZERO for any frames missed.
10. LANE ASSIGNMENTS - Assigned at the time of check-in. A member meeting will be conducted minutes prior to start time in a designated area. Practice will be allowed for 15 minutes prior to scoring. Altering of approaches is NOT allowed. Bowling ball surface work must be completed during practice. Altering of balls once competition begins is NOT allowed! Violation is subject to Disqualification.
11. ACCEPTANCE - NASSBT reserves the right to accept or reject anyone from membership in this organization.
12. RULES -- Governed by USBC rules. The Tournament Director has final say on all disputes \& interpretation.
13. QUALIFYING -- A one out of four ratio will be used for qualifying in this tournament.

For every four 70+ (SSS) below the cutline, the single highest of the four will be advanced into the elimination round. Women $60+$ will be included in this category unless there are four women bowling in the qualifying round. If four women are bowling in the qualifying round, any female bowler 60+ will not be included in the SSS category and will be using the one out of four ratio for placing into the elimination round.
14. ELIGIBILITY -- * NO PBA /PWBA current member or National Tour Titleholders are eligible. Anyone having won a PBA/PWBA regional event will be ineligible to bowl until 10 years have passed since that win was achieved. Anyone, having won $\$ 10,000.00$ or more in a single event will be ineligible to bowl until 10 years have passed since that win.
All NASSBT bowlers will be limited to 3 titles or $\$ \mathbf{\$ 3 , 0 0 0}$ in total winnings during 2023 calendar year from regular events. *This limitation DOES NOT include Doubles, T of C, or Year End Tournament. Non-Champs Tournament -- You must have bowled in 2 tournaments within the past year. Year End Tournament -- A minimum of 3 tournaments during the current year.
