

Below you will find the rules for McMillan Park and its pavilion which were adopted by the Board of Directors of Indian Shores Property Owners Association, Inc. on October 21, 2017. ISPOA takes great pride in managing this beautiful park for our members and members' guests. Please abide by all rules to ensure the enjoyment of all association members. (Updated 2020)

PARK RULES

1. ISPOA, INC. MEMBERS ONLY.
2. GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE ISPOA DUES/FEE PAYER.
3. LEAVE NO TRACE — REMOVE ALL TRASH AND/OR OTHER ITEMS WHEN LEAVING.
4. NO CAMPING.
5. NO VEHICLES/TRAILERS/BOATS LEFT OVERNIGHT.
6. NO LOUD MUSIC.
7. NO FIREWORKS/EXPLOSIVES/OPEN FLAMES OR COOKING ARE PERMITTED ON THE PAVILION OR ANY OTHER WOODEN STRUCTURE.
8. NO COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES.
9. SIGN IN AND OUT AT THE GATE.
10. CLOSE GATE WHEN ENTERING AND EXITING THE PARK.

PAVILION RULES

In general the pavilion and other park facilities may be used on a first come/first served basis. In the spirit of cooperation and common courtesy, please share facilities with other members and/or vacate them when you are done so others may take advantage of them. However, the pavilion may be reserved as follows:

SCHEDULING

1. Reservations are made through the ISPOA secretary at info@indianshoreslakemartin.com and will then appear on the events calendar at <http://indianshoreslakemartin.com>.
2. Hours are: 9:00 am - 9:30 pm. All participants must exit the park by 10:00 pm.
3. Maximum reservation time: 1 day

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

4. ISPOA member will be held accountable for any damages sustained during the event.
5. ISPOA member shall not charge a fee to attend the event.
6. Activities at the pavilion shall not be disruptive to other members' use of other areas in the park.

DECORATIONS

7. Decorations may be tied or freestanding only. No nails, tacks, staples, tape, etc. will be permitted on the posts, tables, railings, deck, etc.
8. No confetti, glitter, or sprinkles will be allowed.
9. No open flames allowed in or on the pavilion.

FOOD PREPARATION

10. No cooking allowed within/on the pavilion — all food must be prepared outside.

CLEANUP

11. The pavilion must be returned to its original setup, and cleaned, with all trash and other items removed from the park.

DONATIONS ARE WELCOMED TO FURTHER THE MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE PARK.

THE ISPOA BOARD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL FUTURE USE OF THE PARK FOR ANY PERSON(S) NOT COMPLYING WITH THE RULES.
