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Habitat for Humanity is accepting Homeowner Applications

**Habitat for Humanity is currently accepting
homeowner applications to build Partner Home
#40.**

**This home will be located in the community of
Sunrise Lake, Milford, PA.**

To qualify for a Habitat home, families are asked to demonstrate their need for shelter, are current residents of Pike County, are able to pay a mortgage with a qualifying family income, and a willingness to partner with our volunteers. Families are required to complete 200 hours of "sweat equity" working on their house prior to occupancy.

A member of our Family Selection Committee will meet with prospective families to review their need for shelter, financial information, etc. in order to select the best candidate for each house. Habitat homeowners are given a 30-year, 0% interest loan to repay Habitat for the cost of the materials and sub-contracted labor.

People often tell us they never knew there was a Habitat for Humanity in Pike County. There are families in Pike County who might qualify and be interested in owning a Habitat home, yet they haven't gotten the word that we exist.

So it seems it's time to spread the word!
