

- Attach fishing line from the rod to the end of the release mechanism. When letting line out use the reel drag tension to avoid tangles.
- Top bolt adjusts tension for release system.
- Attach leader line to the snap swivel. Leader from the diver to the bait should be one rod length.
- 4) Turn bottom of the Torpedo Deep Sea Diver to steer right or left.
- 5) Bottom bolt adjusts tension of the right/left rachet system.
- 6) Attach 4" of fishing line between the Torpedo Diver Cuda and the Torpedo Deep Sea Diver using a snap swivel or each end to achieve depths of 400'.
