Board Member Anthony Richardson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

General Manager Drew Satterwhite reviewed the liabilities with the Board.

Board Member Scott Blackerby made a motion to approve the consent agenda items. Board Member Ken Brawley seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

IX. <u>Consider and act upon Audited Financial Statements for Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 2020</u>.

General Manager Drew Satterwhite provided background information for the Board. Carl Deaton of Hankins, Eastup, Deaton, Tonn & Seay, reviewed the Audit with the Board. Board Member Ken Brawley made the motion to approve the audit. Board Member Anthony Richardson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

X. <u>Consider all matters incident and related to the issuance and sale of "Greater Texoma Utility</u> <u>Authority Contract Revenue Bonds, Series 2021 (Gober Municipal Utility District Project)",</u> <u>including the adoption of a resolution approving the issuance thereof and the facilities to be</u> <u>constructed or acquired by the Authority for the benefit of the District.</u>

General Manager Drew Satterwhite provided background information for the Board. Kristen Savant, Norton Rose Fulbright, provided highlights of the Bond Resolution. Board Member Scott Blackerby made the motion to approve the bond resolution for the Gober MUD project. Board Member Matt Brown seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

XI. <u>Consider and act upon authorization of General Manager to advertise for bids for Gober MUD</u> Water System Improvements Project.

General Manager Drew Satterwhite provided background information for Board. Board Member Anthony Richardson made the motion to authorize the General Manager to advertise for bids for Gober MUD Project. Board Member Scott Blackerby seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

XII.Consider and act upon a Resolution by the Board of Directors of the Greater Texoma Utility
Authority accepting the contract with Western Municipal Construction of Texas, LLC for the Bear
Creek Special Utility District Water Line Project as complete.

General Manager Drew Satterwhite provided background information for the Board. In 2018 Bear Creek SUD requested the Authority's assistance in obtaining funding for their water line project through the Texas Water Development Board's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. The construction contract was awarded to Western Municipal Construction of Texas in the amount of \$994,870.00. This project included furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment for the installation of 6,974' of 12" water line, 1,537' of 16" water line, all associated appurtenances, and connections to existing water line. While the contractor was installing the 12" water line, they encountered a 60" Corrugated Metal Pipe Culvert that was not shown on the plans that crossed the easement perpendicular to the proposed water line. The contractor had to back up and lower the line and hand dig to cross below the culvert. This resulted in Change Order No. 1, an increase of \$14,723.39, for a revised contract amount of \$1,009,593.39. This project was substantially complete on August 1, 2020. We are awaiting some amendments to the current close out documents to clarify when the Warranty Bond begins and corrected amount. The staff recommends authorizing close out of this project contingent upon the receipt of clarified closeout documents and Bear Creek SUD's approval. Board Member Ken Brawley made the motion authorizing close out of this project contingent upon the receipt of finalized closing documents and a similar action from Bear Creek SUD's. Board Member Stanley Thomas seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

XIII. <u>Consider and act upon Statements of Qualifications for Engineering Services for City of</u> <u>Dorchester Water System Improvements Project.</u>

General Manager Drew Satterwhite provided background information for the Board. The City of Dorchester requested assistance in obtaining funding for the construction of a new water well, pump station, ground storage, water lines, appurtenances and other water system projects as funds allow. The Texas Water Development Board Drinking Water State Revolving Fund was selected as the funding source for these improvements. The DWSRF program requires that engineering services be solicited following the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise requirements. The Authority staff solicited engineering services on behalf of the City of Dorchester for this project. Biggs & Mathews, Inc. was selected by the Dorchester Council. Board Member Matt Brown made the motion to confirm the selection of Biggs & Mathews, Inc. as the engineer for the City of Dorchester project. Board Member Scott Blackerby seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

XIV. <u>Consider and act upon Statements of Qualifications for Engineering Services for City of Valley</u> <u>View Wastewater System Improvements Project.</u>

General Manager Drew Satterwhite provided background information for the Board. The City of Valley View requested the Authority to assist in obtaining funding from the Texas Water Development Board Clean Water State Revolving Fund. The funds would be used to upgrade the wastewater treatment plant as well as correct inflow and infiltration issues in their collection system. The Authority assisted the City in obtaining Statements of Qualifications for the engineering services associated with the projects. The City of Valley View selected KJE for engineering services on their Wastewater System Improvements Project. Board Member Anthony Richardson made the motion to confirm the selection of KJE as the engineer for the City of Valley View project. Board Member Scott Blackerby seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

XV. <u>Consider and act upon Statements of Qualifications for Engineering Services for City of</u> Whitewright Wastewater System Improvements Project.

General Manager Drew Satterwhite provided background information for the Board. This is the 2nd time we have done a solicitation for this project. The engineer for the 1st selected firm resigned and the city wanted to re-solicit to be sure they have the most qualified team for the project. The Authority solicited on behalf of the City of Whitewright and six SOQs were received on Friday, however; the City of Whitewright's council meeting will be Tuesday. It is recommended that this item be tabled. Board Member Matt Brown made the motion to table this item. Board Member Scott Blackerby seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

XVI. <u>Receive General Manager's Report: The General Manager will update the Board on operational</u> and other activities of the Authority

General Manager Drew Satterwhite informed the Board that the Bear Creek SUD water rates are being appealed to the Public Utility Commission. In addition, Drew provided updates on several ongoing and upcoming projects.

Next Board Meeting will be February 22, 2021 instead of President's Day, February 15, 2021.

XVII. <u>Adjourn</u>

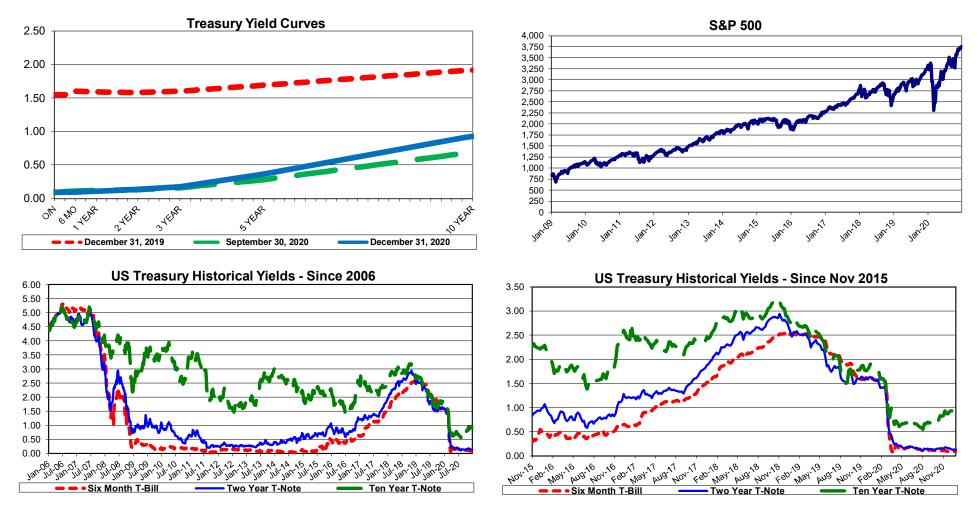

The Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) maintained the Fed Funds target range at 0.00% to 0.25% (Effective Fed Funds are trading +/-0.10%), and projected that reduced rates could remain into 2024. Second estimate of Third Quarter GDP was finalized at +33.4%, but still remains 3.5% below pre-pandemic levels. Crude oil traded above \$50 per barrel. Employment/ Unemployment continues modest improvement. The Stock Markets reached new highs. Housing continues adding positive economic activity. Additional fiscal stimulus passed and was signed by the President. The Yield Curve steepened slightly from last quarter end.

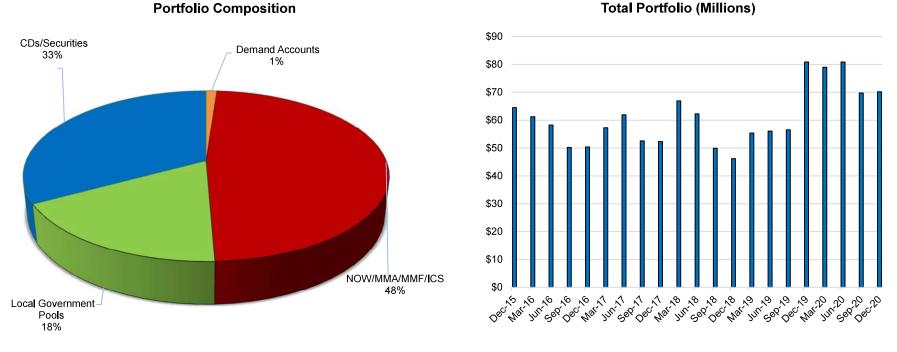
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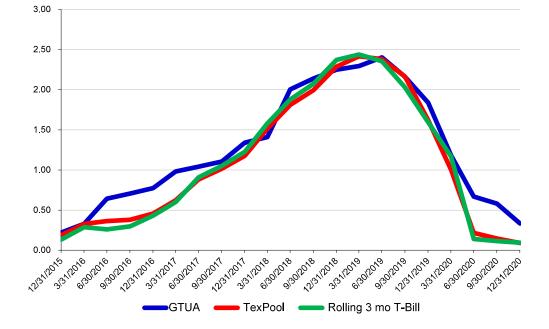

The Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") Drinking Water State Revolving Fund ("DWSRF") was initially selected as the funding source for these improvements. The DWSRF program offers below-market interest rates and is often the best source for funding projects of this nature.

The DWSRF program requires that engineering services be solicited following the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise requirements. The Authority staff solicited engineering services on behalf of the Northwest Grayson County WCID#1 for this project.

CONSIDERATIONS

As discussed elsewhere in the agenda, we may end up pursuing the Development Fund instead of the DWSRF. However, this process was already started prior to consideration of switching funding sources so we believe that we should follow through with the selection.

Three (3) engineering firms, Biggs & Mathews, Inc., NDM (Nathan D. Maier), NS (Neel-Schaffer) provided Statement of Qualifications for the Northwest Grayson County WCID#1 Water System Improvements Project.

At their February meeting, the Northwest Grayson County WCID#1 board met and selecting Biggs & Mathews, Inc.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends that the Board of Directors confirm the Northwest Grayson County WCID#1 selection of Biggs & Mathews, Inc.

<u>ISSUE</u>

Consider and act upon a Resolution by the Board of Directors of the Greater Texoma Utility Authority requesting financial assistance from the Texas Water Development Board, authorizing the filing of an application for assistance, and making certain findings in connection therewith (Northwest Grayson County WCID #1 Water System Improvements Project).

BACKGROUND

The Northwest Grayson County WCID #1 has requested assistance in obtaining funding for improvements to the City's water system. These improvements include a new elevated storage tank, appurtenances and other water system projects as funds allow.

The Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") Drinking Water State Revolving Fund ("DWSRF") was initially selected as the funding source for these improvements. However, the TWDB informed the Authority staff in February that changes had been made to the SRF programs by limiting the amount of funding they are making available. For at least the next 12 months the SRF program funding will be difficult to qualify for and will take significantly more time to be funded if a project ends up qualifying. Due to these changes in the SRF program and discussions with TWDB, the Authority staff is proposing to pursue funding through the Texas Water Development Fund ("DFund"). The DFund is a state funded loan program with below market interest rates.

CONSIDERATIONS

The application is to be filed with the Texas Water Development Board in an amount not to exceed \$2,360,000.00 to provide for the costs of a new elevated storage tank and appurtenances.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends the Board approve the Resolution requesting financial assistance from the TWDB on behalf of the Northwest Grayson County WCID for a new elevated storage tank and appurtenances in an amount not to exceed \$2,360,000.

The Authority staff assisted the City in obtaining Statements of Qualifications ("SOQS") for the engineering services associated with the improvements to Henrietta's wastewater treatment plant. The City of Henrietta selected Biggs and Mathews as the firm to assist in the engineering services associated with the improvements to the wastewater treatment plant.

The Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") Clean Water State Revolving Fund was initially selected as the funding source for these improvements. However, the TWDB informed the Authority staff in February that changes had been made to the State Revolving Funds ("SRF") programs by limiting the amount of funding they are making available. For at least the next 12 months the SRF program funding will be difficult to qualify for and will take significantly more time to be funded if a project ends up qualifying. Due to these changes in the SRF program and discussions with TWDB, the Authority staff is proposing to pursue funding through the Texas Water Development Fund ("DFund"). The DFund is a state funded loan program with below market interest rates.

CONSIDERATIONS

The application is to be filed with the Texas Water Development Board in an amount not to exceed \$10,235,000.00 to provide for the costs of improvements to the City of Henrietta Wastewater Treatment Plant.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

CONSIDER AND ACT UPON A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GREATER TEXOMA UTILITY AUTHORITY REQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE, AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH (CITY OF VALLEY VIEW WASTEWATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT).

<u>ISSUE</u>

Consider and act upon a Resolution by the Board of Directors of the Greater Texoma Utility Authority requesting financial assistance from the Texas Water Development Board, authorizing the filing of an application for assistance, and making certain findings in connection therewith (City of Valley View Wastewater System Improvements Project).

BACKGROUND

The City of Valley View requested the Authority staff assist the City of Valley View in obtaining funding from the Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB"). They have a wastewater plant that needs to be upgraded as well as some inflow and infiltration issues in their collection system. These issues need to be looked at as a whole and we believe that there needs to be preliminary engineering performed to dive further into these issues in order for the City to select the appropriate path forward on capital improvements.

The Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") Clean Water State Revolving Fund was initially selected as the funding source for these improvements. However, the TWDB informed the Authority staff in February that changes had been made to the State Revolving Funds ("SRF") programs by limiting the amount of funding they are making available. For at least the next 12 months the SRF program funding will be difficult to qualify for and will take significantly more time to be funded if a project ends up qualifying. Due to these changes in the SRF program and discussions with TWDB, the Authority staff is proposing to pursue funding through the Texas Water Development Fund ("DFund"). The DFund is a state funded loan program with below market interest rates.

CONSIDERATIONS

The application is to be filed with the Texas Water Development Board in an amount not to exceed \$700,000.00 to provide for the costs of testing, planning and design for improvements to the City of Valley View Wastewater System.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends the Board approve the Resolution requesting financial assistance from the TWDB on behalf of the City of Valley View for testing, planning, and designing the Wastewater System in an amount not to exceed \$700,000.

<u>ISSUE</u>

Consider and act upon a Resolution by the Board of Directors of the Greater Texoma Utility Authority requesting financial assistance from the Texas Water Development Board, authorizing the filing of an application for assistance, and making certain findings in connection therewith (City of Bells Wastewater System Improvements Project).

BACKGROUND

The City of Bells requested the Authority staff to assist the City in obtaining funding from the Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") Clean Water State Revolving Fund ("CWSRF") and the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund ("DWSRF") for rehabilitation of water distribution lines and repairs to the wastewater treatment plant.

The Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") State Revolving Funds ("SRF") were initially selected as the funding sources for these improvements. However, the TWDB informed the Authority staff in February that changes had been made to the SRF programs by limiting the amount of funding they are making available. For at least the next 12 months the SRF program funding will be difficult to qualify for and will take significantly more time to be funded if a project ends up qualifying. Due to these changes in the SRF program and discussions with TWDB, the Authority staff is proposing to pursue funding through the Texas Water Development Fund ("DFund"). The DFund is a state funded loan program with below market interest rates.

CONSIDERATIONS

The application is to be filed with the Texas Water Development Board in an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00 to provide for the costs of improvements to the City of Bells Water/Wastewater System.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS
