Sealed bids for the construction of 0.850 MGD Wastewater Treatment Plant will be received by Greater Texoma Utility Authority on Behalf of City of Henrietta until 1:30 PM Tuesday, December 16, 2025, at City of Henrietta, 101 N. Main, Henrietta, Texas 76365 and then publicly opened and read aloud.

A Pre-Bid conference is not scheduled for this project.

The major items to be furnished and installed are:

Construction of 0.850 MGD Wastewater Treatment Plant, including raw wastewater lift station, aeration basin, clarifiers, sludge drying beds, chlorine contact basin, yard piping and miscellaneous site work.

Bidders must submit with their bids a Bid Bond in the amount of Five (5%) percent of the maximum amount of bid payable to the Greater Texoma Utility Authority on Behalf of City of Henrietta from a reliable surety company as a guarantee that Bidder will enter into a contract and execute bond and guarantee forms provided within fourteen (14) days after notice of award of contract to him. Bids submitted without a bid bond will not be considered.

This contract is contingent upon the release of funds from the Texas Water Development Board. Any contract or contracts awarded under this Advertisement for Bids is/are expected to be funded in part by a loan or grant from the Texas Water Development Board.

Any contract(s) awarded under this Advertisement for Bids is/are subject to the United States Iron and Steel (U.S. I&S) requirements of Texas Water Code 17.183 and Texas Government Code, Chapter 2252, Subchapter F, as amended by SB 1289, 85th Legislative Session, as applicable.

The bidder will complete and submit form TWDB-0459, *Vendor Compliance with Reciprocity on Non-Resident Bidders* , with the bid. This form is included in the Contract Documents.

The successful Bidder must furnish bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Texas to act as surety and acceptable according to the latest list of companies holding certificates of authority from the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner. Owners have the right to reject any and/or all bids, and to waive any informalities in the bidding process. In addition, a two (2) year warranty is required for all work on this project.
