All dogs entered must be at the test site Home Base at the time of the draw. Judging will begin when the tracks have sufficiently aged.

Entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted after the closing date and time. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries.

Entry fee: \$125 for VST. Fees must be paid in U.S. funds. Make checks payable to GWFCR Club. One check per entry is required. This includes a .50 cent recording fee and \$3.00 event fee for the AKC.

Arbitration

GWFCR Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

Drawing of Entries Thursday, June 13, 2024 6:30 PM PST

A drawing to fill entry limits will be held at 106 Briar Rose, Irvine CA 92618. Entrants will be notified within 48 hours and an alternates list maintained if necessary.

BREED ELIGIBILITY: Dogs must be an AKC registered purebred or a purebred in one of the following categories: Dogs registered with an AKC Limited Registration number, or dogs with a PAL (Purebred Alternative Listing) or ILP (Indefinite Listing Privilege) number. Dogs registered as AKC Canine Partners (All Americans) may also enter. The AKC LRN, PAL, ILP or CP number must be shown on the entry form. A dog approved for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows and a dog of a Foundation Stock Service recorded breed that meets the eligibility requirements for competition are eligible to compete provided their AKC identification number appears on the entry form.

ENTRY DRAWING: GWFCRC has implemented the Test Worker option, giving preference for 1 VST track to past workers. Entries of dogs will be accepted only to the extent that the limit of entries is NOT filled by 1) Specialty breed without a VST title and with a TD or TDX title; 2) Specialty breed with a VST title; 3) Other breeds without a VST title and with a TD title; and 4) Other breeds with a VST title.

A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will be held to determine the participants in the test. The order of the draw shall be in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Tracking Regulations. These tests are open to all AKC registered breeds of dogs as listed above, however, the draw for entries will be done for the respective tests as stated above.

NOTIFICATION: Alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, the first alternate entry present according to the order in which they were drawn shall assume the vacant position.

10 Day Rule: No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within ten (10) days prior to the date of the event. People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past 10 days, they have boarded, laid track for, or regularly trained the dogs whoe tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer mjust not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler.

Entry Information

No entry fees will be refunded except the entry fee for an entry that pulls before the closing date; or an entry and/or alternate that does not participate when another alternate is present to replace him/her prior to the track draw. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. Entries will not be accepted without fee. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Test Secretary will add the fee charged by the bank to the amount of each returned check. Faxed, telephone, E-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC form and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms are not acceptable. No refunds for duplicate entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge or barred from competition by action of the Tracking Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or acts beyond the control of GWRCR Club and/or the Tracking Committee it is impossible to open or to complete the test, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Bitches in season: may participate in this test in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. Entry fees and certifications shall be returned in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.
