Bitches in season may participate in accordance with AKC
Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8. Please keep
bitches in season in your vehicle and notify the Test Secretary
upon arrival.

Entries of dogs will be accepted only to the extent that the limit
is NOT filled by:

- 1) Dog without a VST title and with TD (or TDU) title
- 2) Dog with a VST title

ENTRY FEE:

\$135.00 for the VST Test (fee includes the required AKC
Recording Fee and AKC Event Service Fee). Make checks
payable to HDOC, Inc. One (1) check per entry, fees in US
funds.

Entries must be made on an official AKC entry form that
includes the Agreement. Do not send entries by any method
requiring a signature for delivery.

A drawing to determine participants required by AKC in the
Tracking Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 12, will be held at
6:00 p.m. Wednesday, November 13, 2019 at 411 North
Lomita Street, Burbank, CA 91506.

ALL CANCELLATIONS of entries must be made in writing to
the Test Secretary and received prior to the stated date and
time of closing entries. Entry fees will be returned to those who
did not make the draw after the test. Should an entry that
made the draw need to cancel, the entry fee will be returned
provided an alternate is available to fill the spot.

JUDGING:

VST tracks for the competitors drawn on November 13, 2019 will be drawn at **8:30 a.m. Sunday, November 24, 2019**. All dogs drawn for tracks must be at the test site (California State University, Channel Islands, 1 University Drive, Camarillo, CA 93012) at the time of the draw for running order of tracks.

Judging will begin when the tracks have aged sufficiently, but not before 9:00 a.m.

By their presence on the Test grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by the AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Test Committee to the best of their ability. The owner or agent entering a dog in a Variable Surface Tracking Test does so at his or her own risk.

Exhibitors must be aware that the test may be cancelled if extreme weather conditions arise.

DOGS SHALL BE KEPT ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES IN ANY AREA OF THE TEST SITE. ANY DOG THAT IS IN THE TRACKING TEST THAT IS NOT ON A LEASH BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE TRACKING TESTS WILL **NOT QUALIFY.**

Potty all dogs in designated dog-potty area only. There will be signs posted. If you do not see the signs, please ask the Test Secretary for the location of the designated dog-potty area.

Light refreshments will be furnished for exhibitors and spectators on test day.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
