

2025 Crochet-along Sampler Blanket

What is a Blanket Crochet-along?

Crochet-alongs are generally online patterns for larger projects, such as blankets, where the patterns are released in stages. Participants can crochet the individual parts at the same time from anywhere. Pictures are submitted to be shared at the end. It is a great way to learn new stitches as a beginner or new stitches as a seasoned pro.

- Use your own yarn, choose your own colors, even choose how many rows for each stitch.
- Receive a "Stitch of the Week" email with directions for that week with step-by-step instructions. You are encouraged to complete no less than two rows of each stitch.
- The last two weeks will be border rows.

Yarns

Use any type of yarn you prefer and the hook size necessary for that yarn. It is suggested that you use the same weight yarn throughout.

You can choose to use any color, color schemes, themes, to repeat colors or not.

Examples: Pick all pastels for a spring theme, fall colors for an autumnal theme, or all the colors of the rainbow.

Size

Baby Blanket - Beginning chain should be between 100 and 130.

Lap-gan - slightly bigger than a baby blanket, maybe chain 150-175

Blanket - chain more than 175 to desired width.

Cost

A one-time fee of \$10 per participant.
