Workshop Description:

This workshop is designed for early childhood educators, caregivers, and curriculum developers who seek to create rich, engaging, and joyful learning experiences for preschoolers through real experiences. The focus is on designing an experiential curriculum that emphasizes play, exploration, and hands-on learning as opposed to precut activities. By immersing children in real-world activities, educators will discover how to foster creativity, critical thinking, and emotional growth in young learners. Through this approach, children will grow in all areas of development and also experience the joy and excitement of learning through meaningful, interactive engagement with each other and the world. The workshop will emphasize how an experiential curriculum nurtures curiosity, promotes self-expression, and supports emotional well-being in young children. Educators will leave with many ideas to grow their classrooms into vibrant, joyful learning environments that inspire children to explore and learn with enthusiasm through meaningful experiences. *COK hours: Child Development 1.5, Curriculum/1.5*
