What precipitated the Truckers Convoy?



Canada had some of the strictest and most stringent Covid lockdowns in the world. From the outset it was clear that we would follow the science; the World Health Organization, Dr. Fauci, the Centre for Disease Control and mostly, the World Economic Forum, of which Trudeau is a devoted follower. Rule by fear and Doctors opinions be damned.

We were locked down for almost 2 years. Businesses and families were destroyed. Places of worship forced to close (except for Mosques) and Pastors who disobeyed were arrested, fined & jailed. People were suffocating in masks and forced masking on children was nothing less than child abuse. If we travelled, we were faced with 14 days of isolation upon return, and sometimes could not travel between Provinces. We could not have more than 2 guests in our homes. We had curfews from 10 p.m. – 6 a.m. We were being threatened with fines if we remained unvaxxed. In my Province, the unvaxxed were only allowed to enter certain food stores and pharmacies only. No box stores were allowed. No access to beauty salons; gyms; sporting events, movie theatres, restaurants.

We had many brave doctors, nurses, airline pilots, teachers standing up but to no avail. Trudeau had been totally intransigent on vaccines and there was to be no discussion.

And this was the genesis of the Truckers Convoy. It was not just about being able to cross back and forth across the US/Canada border without the Vaxxport (90% of the truckers were vaccinated). It was about bringing back our freedoms – guaranteed to us under The Charter of Rights and Freedoms which include freedom of conscience, freedom of religion, freedom of thought, freedom of belief, freedom of expression, freedom of the press, freedom of peaceful assembly and freedom of association. These are our inalienable rights.

The truckers reminded us that Freedom of speech, thought, belief and the right to life, liberty and security of the person are guaranteed. We do not need to beg, barter or ask for them...they are ours for the taking.

AND THEN CAME THE TRUCKERS TO THE RESCUE!!

For thirty-three days, the world watched. Crossing ten provinces and three territories; thousands of trucks traversed the highways and by-ways of Canada's northern climes in this extraordinary moment in Canadian history.

Through gentle resistance, the Canadian truckers and protesters inflicted an injury to the principle of authority that awakened the world to the realization that



totalitarianism hinges on compliance, showing that We the people *must* stand up and take back our freedoms from the self-proclaimed "elites" to end our enslavement. Badass tyranny resister Pastor Artur Pawlowski urged Canadian truckers to hold the line, and airline pilot Greg Hill explained why summoning courage was so pivotal at this moment in history.

And summon courage they did, becoming a catalyst that would spark Freedom Convoys around the globe—most notably in Australia, where the Canberra convoy rose from the ashes of the Australians' despondency and reinvigorated a downtrodden people. In Paris, the police joined the protesters in denouncing Macronian authoritarianism. These demonstrators would not have been so emboldened without the Canadian truckers' example.

The truckers did not do this for themselves. Indeed, they risked everything—their income, their licenses, their rigs, their assets, even their freedom. The State threatened to take their children away and said that if they were arrested, their dogs would be seized and considered "relinquished" after eight days. They fearlessly put everything on the line to fight for the freedom of not only Canadians but all of humanity.

The last living signatory of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms, Brian Peckford delivered an electrifying speech in which he announced the filing of a lawsuit against the government for violating this sacred charter.

Naturally Trudeau, along with World Economic Forum -penetrated Cabinet members; and the complicitous, state-funded media fabricated an ersatz narrative so incongruous with the thousands of hours of live-streamed joy that only the most brainwashed failed to recognize the uproarious dissonance.

And what happened next was magic!

Most of you know the back story by now. Possibly the most peaceful mass protest in human history, instigated by truckers from across Canada who converged in the country's capital on January 29, 2022, was crushed two weeks and six days later, on Friday, February 18. This was four days after Trudeau invoked the never before used Emergencies Act of 1988.

By the time he did so on February 14, the solidarity protests and blockades at the two Canada/US border crossings in Ontario (including the Ambassador Bridge over which one-quarter of trans-border transport occurs) had ended peacefully. The remaining two crossings in Manitoba and Alberta would be cleared the next day. There had also been no protest-related violence in Ottawa itself. There were no injuries, broken windows, vandalism, damaged statues, or assaults on police.

What transpired on Parliament Hill for three weeks less a day was an unprecedented protest-plus party. Throngs of people draped in or carrying flags turned the Hill into a sea of red and white, especially on weekends. They decorated the palisades of the Parliamentary grounds with their signs. They played street hockey, had pig roasts, erected Bouncy Castles for the children and sang and danced in the streets.

And how were they met by Trudeau? QUOTE:

"Today in the house, Members of Parliament unanimously condemned the antisemitism, Islamophobia, anti-Black racism, homophobia and transphobia that



we're seen on display in Ottawa over the past number of days. Together let's keep working to make Canada more inclusive."

The truckers' expedition to Ottawa was about much more than vaccine dictates – it was about lifting the yoke of government impositions from the necks of the Canadian people – the unending cycles of lockdowns and restrictions that were destroying livelihoods and killing freedom in the name of fighting Covid. The Canadian people were fully on board with the truckers' objectives, braving freezing weather to cheer them on along roadways and from overpasses.

It was after two years of Covid authoritarianism that in Canada the largest truck convoy in history had smashed through the Berlin Wall of tyranny. I watched as the Canada I knew and loved turned into one of the most repressive countries on earth. I wondered how a freedom-loving people could allow themselves to be abused by these mini-Stalins without a peep. But then Canada stood up and showed the rest of the world that freedom can triumph over tyranny if the people demand it. As I say, no army can stop an idea whose time has come.

And this was the genesis of the Truckers Convoy. It was not just about being able to cross back and forth across the US/Canada border without the Vaxxport. My friend, Madie Weld, described it perfectly:

"The roaring of the engines and the honking of the horns of those trucks sounded to me like the pounding of hooves as the cavalry rides to the rescue. May those truckers have a great success on their mission. This convoy convention is not just for them. It's for all of us."

Some organizers for **Freedom Convoy 2022** said they wouldn't leave Ottawa until their demands were met, while denouncing any forms of violence and intimidation and calling on all demonstrators to remain calm and peaceful. "We're not coming here to be aggressive or hateful or cause violence," protest organizer Tamara Lich told The Epoch Times while passing Sudbury, Ont., on her way to Ottawa. "We're going to be staying in for as long as it takes. We're not leaving until Canada is free."

I had never been more proud of my Canadian roots than during the Freedom Convoy. I want to tell the story first hand because those who control the five major megaphones in much of the world worked overtime to suppress this story. I won't let them succeed.



The Freedom Convoy had inspired truckers from across Canada, the United States, and now the world. Some of the most influential, intelligent, and rational world industrious leaders like Elon Musk, Jordan Peterson, Joe Rogan, Tucker Carlson and others, repeatedly expressed their support for Canadian truckers and the working people who are fed up with our global leaders infringing on our rights and freedoms. And for all of us fighting for freedom, we felt SO sure that January 29 – the day the truckers arrived in Ottawa – would be a day that would go down in history.

Trudeau said that we were holding unacceptable views! Talk about dangerous rhetoric coming from a leader. I am glad that he made that statement because I am sure he now had another 20,000 more people to show up in Ottawa and had increased the convoy by an extra mile. You are a liar, and you know we know you're lying.

In Ottawa, the Mayor tried to remove the trucks. All the towing companies contacted said "sorry, we're all out with Covid"!! The RCMP attempted to get the contracted support of a Western Canada towing company, Inter-Pacific Transportation, in the effort to break up the Alberta truck blockade in/around the border crossing between Coutts, Alberta (CA) and Sweet Grass, Montana (USA). However, the towing company released a public statement saying they stand with their brothers, the truck drivers.

Chief Sloly in Ottawa (he was subsequently fired) outlined that federal intelligence authorities will be "collecting financial, digital, vehicle registration, driver identification, insurance status and other related evidence that will be used in prosecution." The jackboots will focus on using acts of mischief, hate, harassment, intimidation and other threatening behaviors, whether real or created by Canadian intelligence operations, to target the protestors.

This is exactly how Fascism and Communism rise inside the walls of a previously free and independent system.

The Globe and Mail, which is Canada's version of CNN, The New York Times, MSNBC, and The WaPo put together, started cranking out defamatory articles. My favorite is the one entitled "Ottawa police probe desecration of monuments by trucker convoy protests." Like me, I bet you're thinking of American monuments in the summer of 2020 after BLM was finished with them: covered with spray-painted obscenities, splattered with paint, and often dragged down by a roaring mob. No such things took place in Ottawa.

OUR BIGGEST ENEMY - THE MEDIA

The Canadian Broadcasting Company – the CBC – is federally funded to the tune of \$1.6 billion every year. When Trudeau came into power, he gave out \$600 million to news agencies that would support him. Organizations that do not support him are left to struggle for funding and they are often banned from public announcements on Parliament Hill or Trudeau rallies. We have only a few in Canada – Rebel News (which is really FOX of the North), True North, The Counter Signal, Spencer Fernando and Brad Salzberg who fearlessly stand up for the truth; who expose Trudeau's scandals but receive no funding. And now, Ezra Levant of the independent media outlet Rebel News has just been denied



'Qualified Canadian Journalism Organization' status which is necessary to be eligible for federal tax credits and other programs.

"The Advisory Board's assessment is that Rebel News does not produce original news content, on the basis that the content was found to be largely opinion-based and focused on the promotion of one particular perspective," the letter said. The letter then stated there is no formal right to appeal a refusal to be granted the qualified Canadian journalism organization (QCJO) status.

Rebel News publisher Ezra Levant told The Epoch Times the fact that the government can decide who qualifies as approved media is "not appropriate for a free country."

On top of this, Trudeau is introducing Bill C-11 to regulate Canada's internet. According to the Bill, search engines, like Google, will be required to boost news organizations that promote "racialized communities, cultural and linguistic minorities, LGBTQ2+ communities, and persons with disabilities." Consequently, non-compliant news publishers not focusing on such progressive topics will be punished by receiving lower rankings in searches. Trusted organizations like the ones I mentioned before will be shuffled to the last page of search results.

So, here are some of the media lies from the Freedom Convoy:

Media Lie No. 1: The crowds thronging to support the truckers are Canada's 'most aggressive citizens," hate-spewing white misogynists and racists

The convoy spirit was not just in Ottawa, however; it was across the whole land and it was infectious. The owner of a trucking company describes the reports from his truckers in the convoy who were moved to tears by the generosity and support of Canadians across the land giving free food, hotel rooms on the house, half-price fuel, welcoming the truckers with smiles and open doors and arms.

Media Lie No. 2: It's a "small fringe minority."

This phrase "small fringe minority" has become an international joke. Prime Minister Justin Trudeau first used it to describe one of the largest nonviolent protests in history and then the phrase was echoed by tax-funded media. The government-subsidized CBC has consistently downsized the convoys and the gathering, reporting that on Saturday, January 29, a mere 8,000 people were in Ottawa.

The photos of the size of the crowd that converged in Ottawa in the sub-zero temperatures on that weekend was easily in the hundreds of thousands. It also does not include the hundreds of thousands of Canadians who stood on bridges, spilled out alongside the highways across the country, or escorted the truckers part of the way.

Media Lie No. 3: The Trucker Convoy is led by white supremacist males.

None of the media have shown the courage to feature the woman who sparked the convoy, its crowdfunding organizers, Saskatchewan-born Tamara Lich, a calm,



Métis-blood mother and grandmother and my friend BJ Dichter, a trucker and a Jew. Real racists – an Indian and a Jew!!

Media Lie No. 4: The Freedom Convoy is all anti-vaxxer

An inconvenient fact for the media is that many in the throng they hate are vaccinated. The truth is, vaccinated and unvaccinated are standing together against the government and vaccine passports.

Media Lie No. 5: The Freedom Convoy put the city in disarray and disrupted the lives of locals

Another inconvenient truth for media: The government has closed the businesses in Ottawa, not the truckers. The government is refusing to recognize Charter Rights and Freedoms of its citizens, not the truckers.

Media Lie No. 6: The protesters are violent

There are endless scenes, captured on film, from Ottawa that show the peaceful nature of the protest: truckers playing hockey in the streets, truckers making pizzas, people holding hands singing "We are the World." Police on the ground testified to the peacefulness of the event.

Meanwhile a man with a known history as an anarchist activist was charged in Winnipeg for running into Convoy protesters. It is being treated as a hit and run rather than a hate crime!

Media Lie No. 7: Protesters are begging for food from the local homeless shelters

The convoy denied any involvement in the incident, which was never confirmed, and police reported there had been no arrests and they spent the rest of their time in Ottawa feeding the homeless.

Media Lie No. 8: Freedom protesters defaced a statue of a national hero.

Terry Fox. Our national hero who got cancer at age 17; lost a leg and started a cross Canada run to raise money for cancer research. Sadly, he died before it was completed. Some protesters at the Freedom Convoy draped a statue of Terry Fox in Ottawa in a Canadian flag, put a MANDATE FREEDOM sign in his hands, and a maple leaf ball cap on his head. These were removed and the statue was guarded and protected for the rest of the protest.

Media Lie No. 9: Truckers were irreverent to war memorials

According to the lying media, there were people urinating and dancing on the War Memorial. No arrests were ever made. There were also many other protesters' signs honoring veterans, reminding of the price they paid to secure the freedoms we have lost.

In any case, the convoy's support of those who fought for our country and liberty had been clear. Their GoFundMe page states that, "Any leftover donations will be donated to a credible Veterans organization which will be chosen by the donors." That was before our fascist government closed the GoFundMe page.

Media Lie No. 10: The best one of all. It was orchestrated by Russia!



We've heard in Canada that our very organic, grassroots millions-strong movement dominated by trucks, flags and cardboard signs made on kitchen tables was "a Jan. 6 insurrection" funded by Trumpists in America. We've heard it was orchestrated by the "far right." But the most hilariously absurd accusation came straight from the CBC, of course: Canada's Trucker Freedom Convoy was instigated by Russia.

According to Mark Carney, Board member of the World Economic Forum, former Governor of the Bank of Canada and the Bank of England, anyone sending money to the convoy should be in no doubt: You are funding SEDITION!! Foreign funders of an insurrection interfered in our domestic affairs from the start. Canadian authorities should take every step within the law to identify and thoroughly punish them. The involvement of foreign governments and any officials connected to them should be identified, exposed and addressed. Was Fake News feeding Mark Carney these lies?

Now it's time to crush it

First, GoFundMe is taken down after raising over \$12 million and the funds frozen. The Canadian government demanded that the funds are put in "escrow" to help pay policing costs in Ottawa!! Fortunately, over \$1 million was in Bitcoin which had already been distributed to the truckers. GoFundMe was finally humiliated into returning the donations, thanks to people like Elon Musk, Ted Cruz and Jim Jordan speaking out. Next came GiveSendGo, who raised over \$2 million in 2 days and a total of approximately \$10 million – which again, the Canadian government demanded they hand over. Fortunately, they refused and since the money sits in the United States, the Canadian government has no right to it. And it still sits there as they cannot transfer it to anyone involved with the Truckers Convoy as many of those bank accounts are still frozen.

February 14, 2022 – Valentine's Day – Brings in Emergencies Act (previously War Measures ACT)

Let's get the legalities out of the way first. The hacked donor base of GiveSendGo was obtained through the commission of a cybercrime. Distributing the stolen data <u>itself</u> is another cybercrime. Further, possessing stolen materials on your computer is a cybercrime. There's no exception for, "but the victims are bad people!" or even, "but the victims are criminals themselves!"

Canada doesn't allow citizens to take the law into their own hands and commit crimes in the name of real or perceived justice, for obviously good reasons. Doxing average donors isn't just morally and legally dubious; it's dangerous. So are the calls to extend harassment and reprisals to donors' spouses, family members, business associates, and friends.

Slandering the truckers wasn't enough. Being called a "Nazi" didn't make them go away. Trudeau, therefore, declared martial law via Canada's Emergencies Act. In addition to the usual police powers to arrest people who offended Trudeau, Trudeau's government announced that it would shut down all crowdfunding



platforms, attack cryptocurrencies, and unilaterally seize the bank accounts of anyone protesting Trudeau's COVID policies or supporting the protesters.

FREEZING BANK ACCOUNTS & CONSEQUENCES

And Now, It's Economic Warfare

The Canadian government had declared that it can freeze anyone's bank account and seize the contents based on their political views or charitable actions. These days, a Tiananmen-style solution takes a different form. With financial intermediaries forced to do the state's bidding, rebellions can be put down with texts, emails, and a few clicks on an interface. Your assets are frozen, then stolen, and you are left without a job or any financial means at all. Jails aren't even necessary.

Something very serious was happening in the background of the Canadian financial system, and it appeared the leaders inside government, as well as leaders in the international financial community, were reacting and trying to keep things quiet.

A promotional video from the Canadian Bankers Association helps to neatly connect all the dots about why the Canadian government made such a quick reversal in their bank asset seizures within 24 hours. It was almost certainly contact from the World Economic Forum to Canadian Finance Minister Chrystia Freeland that triggered the change in position. And suddenly, after the banks screamed about massive withdrawals, Trudeau backed down. OOPS!!!

Trudeau had created a very serious crisis and just rescinding his Emergency Act was not going to make it all better. Trudeau had driven a stake through the heart of the Canadian economy and that meant that international capital would be skeptical about trusting Canada as long Trudeau is in power.

But the Trudeau reversal motive then surfaced – Canadian Banking Association Was Approved by the World Economic Forum To Lead the Digital ID Creation!!

Economic Warfare is being waged in Canada for all the world to see as witnessed by Trudeau's imposition of the Emergencies Act and the freezing of bank accounts of anyone who does not agree with Trudeau's ideology. "What we are seeing right now in Ottawa reveals the hegemonic depth of the system that gave us lockdowns, then mandates: it is now capable of freezing your accounts and essentially starving you and your family. It's economic warfare.

AS AN ASIDE:

During this period of time, at least 20 violent far-left terrorists broke into the Coastal Gaslink Company in British Columbia and caused millions of dollars in damage to costly equipment. Although the attack on critical infrastructure took place while the Emergencies Act was still in effect, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau did not apply it to track down the suspects involved or to freeze their assets like he did with the Ottawa trucker convoy demonstrators.

And then FINTRAC (Canada's financial monitoring agency) destroyed the Liberals' Narrative - Convoy Funding Not "Terrorism" Or "Money Laundering"



The great lie around the invocation of the Emergencies Act was totally shattered in testimony before the House of Commons finance committee. The deputy director of FINTRAC testified under oath that financial support for the Freedom Convoy 2022 organization came from everyday Canadians fed up with COVID restrictions and was not terrorism or money laundering.

Let's talk about one of the organizers, Tamara Lich. Tamara Lich was arrested as she walked along the streets of Ottawa. As she was handcuffed, she said "Hold The Line". She was denied bail and spent the weekend in solitary confinement and was forbidden to speak from prison. In essence, she became a political prisoner, largely because she embarrassed the government. She has been portrayed in the media as a violent criminal, a foreign operative, and an anarchist. Nothing could be further from the truth. She is a former energy worker of Metis heritage, a mother, and grandmother.

Lich's bail conditions ban her from speaking out against the Canadian government's COVID rules on social media and online and attending any COVID protests. She also has to reside at her Alberta house as directed by police, must report to them, and is to have no contact with the co-accused. **Lich** has no history of any criminal charges from her past, and she was not involved in any violence during the Freedom Convoy.

ON FEBRUARY 19, THE VIOLENCE BEGINS

One of the organizers, my friend, BJ Dichter, met with his road captains that morning. The night before, the Police had broken the windows of a truck and dragged the trucker out, handcuffed him and placed him under arrest. They realized then that the government had now turned violent like a third world dictatorship and decided that it was time for them to go.

Ben explained to the road captains that quote "It's time for us to go. We cannot have drivers and our supporters get injured. The government and the police are completely out of control. We can litigate this in the future. Let's get everyone out of here safely." They were all reluctant to leave, but they agreed and echoed my sentiment – we hadn't come to Ottawa for physical altercations, to fight, or risk truck drivers being beaten mercilessly by their own government.

This had become a political matter for which Trudeau would increase his extremism, because he had become a laughingstock for the international community. We have done our job and woken-up reasonable people to the extremist faction running Canada's and Ontario's government. People were now paying attention.

One of our supporters who had been working with the media team, doing onthe-ground reporting and sharing video content, came to my hotel room, short of breath, telling me that the police were on the move. He told me that they were boxing-in everyone on Rideau Street, so they cannot leave, preparing for mass arrests. I could hardly believe it. We had notified the police about our imminent departure, something the road captains were instructed to tell the remaining drivers. He said the police were kittling demonstrators. Then another volunteer came in with corroboration .

I started sending messages to our teams in the various chat groups to inform them of what was happening.



After nearly a month of peaceful civil disobedience in Canada, the festive atmosphere transformed from Christmas to Kristallnacht as fascism lashed back.

Instead of listening to the concerns of its citizens, the Canadian government and its colluders did the following:

banned honking;

brutally arrested those who violated this injunction;

illegally stole GoFundMe donations;

froze GiveSendGo donations;

shut down the Freedom Convoy Facebook page;

seized fuel and then returned it contaminated;

tried to entrap protesters with agent provocateurs;

attempted to set fire to an apartment building (foiled by the truckers and later confirmed to be a hoax);

declared a "state of emergency" and invoked the Emergencies Act without meeting the necessary threshold, setting the stage for future violations of Canadians' inalienable rights;

flew in UN troops to disburse the protesters;

rifle-whipped protesters;

mowed down and tear-gassed protestors;

trampled an elderly disabled Mohawk woman just after she'd said they were doing this so their children and grandchildren could have "peace and love and happiness";

clubbed and tear-gassed reporter Alexa Lavoie in the face;

staged an arrest;

beat and faux-arrested demonstrators;

froze and seized donor bank accounts and crypto wallets (although the latter has proven more challenging);

threatened to "actively look to identify you and follow up with financial sanctions and criminal charges" in the coming months; and

laid the asphalt for digital IDs and a future surveillance state where similar outbursts of freedom become impossible.

If the protesters had been violent or had committed crimes, the Ottawa Police would have arrested those people, and publicized the arrests. To support the government's narrative that the truckers were dangerous, racist, violent, criminal extremists, the police would have informed the public about specific crimes, detailing what happened, the names of persons charged, and which Criminal Code sections they had been charged with violating.



Yet during the first three weeks of the Ottawa protest, prior to the February 14 declaration of a national emergency, police did not charge any trucker with any crime. Some of the truckers' leaders were in daily communication with police. Police even told the truckers where to park their trucks.

"Come, take my truck. Do whatever you gotta

do. The truck is just a material possession.

Freedom is something so much more than that.

So, take my possessions, put me in jail, sue me -

do whatever you gotta do."

~ A Brave Trucker ~

In a speech that may have been responsible for spurring Trudeau to end the Emergencies Act out of fear the Senate was about to vote it down, Senator Donald Neil Plett eloquently eviscerated Trudeau for his historically unprecedented actions and behavior toward Canadian citizens, noting:

"For three weeks, the prime minister did little more than hurl insults. He actually left town and let the crisis fester and worsen. He is supposed to be the prime minister for all Canadians, even those he may disagree with, but he clearly does not see things that way, and the result is that his policies are seriously dividing Canadians.

"Then after three weeks of inaction, Justin Trudeau came out and used the ultimate tool in his toolbox. The nuclear option - the Emergencies Act. It is hard to refute the accusation that this is a Prime Minister who is at war with many of his fellow citizens. Instead of trying to understand their concerns and the impact of his government measures on them, he is now using all the power he can muster to crush them. He has taken the sweeping powers of the Emergencies Act and turned it on the very people who were just asking to be heard.

"This is a prime minister who does not like opposition. He admires the basic dictatorship of China. He does not listen. He preaches. He does not debate, he insults. He does not convince, he imposes."

THE AFTERMATH

When Trudeau went to Europe to call on European leaders to "strengthen our democracies" in standing up to Vladimir Putin regarding Russia's invasion of Ukraine, his reception on the part of some Members of the European Parliament was almost as brutal, metaphorically speaking, as the treatment Freedom Convoy protesters received from his militarized police. They recognized Trudeau as being one of the "rising threats to our democracies" that he came to talk to them about.

German MEP Christine Andersen called him "a disgrace to democracy" and noted that a "prime minister who openly admires the Chinese dictatorship, who is violating fundamental rights by persecuting and criminalizing his own citizens as terrorists simply because they stood up to his twisted idea of democracy, should not address this Parliament."



Croatian MEP Mislav Kolakusic said that under Trudeau's "quasi-liberal boot," Canada, once a symbol of the modern world, had become a symbol of human rights abuses. "We've seen how you trample women with horses, how you block single parents' bank accounts, so they don't even get school fees and their children's medicines; gas, water, and light; and be able to pay their mortgage," he said. Citizens could fight this "dictatorship of the worst kind" by uniting, he concluded.

Romanian MEP Cristian Terhes also tore into Trudeau, calling him "exactly like a tyrant, like a dictator. He's like Ceausescu in Romania." After criticizing the way "science" was being abused to promote the vaccine, Terhes said he had been in contact with truckers in Canada and congratulated and thanked them. "I hope this movement for freedom and rights is spreading all around the world. Because at the end of the day, we have to make sure that all these elected officials understand that they were elected in those offices to work for the people, not to behave like masters of slaves." (Of course, "masters of slaves" is precisely what the globalists are striving for.)

He also said:

"Justin Trudeau cannot come to lecture Putin on democracy in the European Parliament when he walks with hobnail boots over the fundamental rights of the Canadians. People are made now to choose between the Russian imperialist tyranny, promoted by Putin, and the Neo-Marxist tyranny promoted hypocritical leaders such as Trudeau, in which people are deprived of their rights and freedoms and become objects of the state."

Another six Members of the European Parliament criticized Trudeau for his suppression of a peaceful protest.

Trudeau's international reputation will never be the same.

MY PREDICTION

In this Government vs. The People standoff, we will win. Elites have nothing but disdain for the very people they depend on to live—people who work with their hands, so the elites don't have to; who build their homes and buildings; manufacture just about everything they need; repair their electrical, plumbing, and heating systems; install their AC and repair their cars; care for their kids; deliver their food, fuel, building supplies, new ovens, whatever. Teachers, nurses, gas station attendants. The very people the left claims to care about are now domestic terrorists and racists. We'll survive but the elites will fall apart.

This is our "let's roll" moment. The truckers gave us this moment. Let's not squander it because we are too busy or too scared. And we are legion. This movement is international and, unlike a worldwide Marxist movement, it's a force for good. Truckers of the world, unite!
