

EQUIPMEN

- (a) The home team shall decide on which night during the appointed week the match shall be played.
- (b) The home team shall give at least seven days written notice to the visiting team and advise their opponents which will be the first two events played.
- (c) All matches shall start at 7 p.m. unless mutually agreed otherwise.
- Unless mutually agreed otherwise, the order of play shall be:—

Home Team Away Team
1st mixed v 2nd mixed
2nd mixed v 1st mixed
3rd mixed v 3rd mixed
1st mixed v 1st mixed
2nd mixed v 2nd mixed

The order of play in the men's and ladies doubles shall be in accordance with the requirements of the home team captain except in the final round when it shall be the responsibility of the official in charge of the match. No player shall have to play two events consecutively without a ten minutes break between.

- 7. (a) If a player is injured during a match and is unable to continue, the score in the game in which the injury occurred shall:—
 - (I) if the game were completed, stand.
- (ii) if the game were not completed, be recorded as a win for the opposing team with the injured player's team being credited with the score at the time of injury.
- (b) A substitute, if present at a match prior to 8.15 p.m. is eligible to replace an injured player if already nominated in accordance with regulation 4(b). Such substitution will be direct, the substitute being assumed to be of equivalent standard to the injured player for the time of the match, and points scored by the substitute shall count to the team's advantage.
- (c) A team may replace an injured player with an ineligible player subject to the approval of the opposing captain. Such substitution shall be direct as in 7 (b) above but all games involving the ineligible player shall be deemed to be lost with the eneligible player failing to score (see Regulation 8 (a)).
- (d) Once replaced by a substitute an injured player shall not take part again in the match.

REGULATIONS FOR THE HESKETH, LEAGUE AND ST. JOHNS SHIELDS COMPETITIONS

- The competitions shall be played annually between teams in the Southport League on a knock-out basis and the League executive committee shall be responsible for the organisation, including the handicapping and draw for each round.
- (a) Teams shall be given free entry to the competitions and the League executive, at their first meeting, shall decide which divisions shall enter each competition.
- (b) If nominations (see regulation 4) have not been received by November 21, it will be assumed that the team concerned does not wish to enter the competition.
- 3. (a) Matches shall be played by teams consisting of three ladies and three men, playing five mixed doubles events, two men's doubles events and two ladies doubles events, each event to consist of one game of 21 aces. In each team two men and two ladies to form two mixed couples who shall play both the opposing couples in the other team. The remaining two players to form a third mixed couple who shall play the corresponding mixed couple in the other team only: The man/lady from the third mixed couple is to play in turn with each of the other men/ladies in the men's/ladies doubles. Men's/ladies doubles shall be played in order of strength. NB. Where an ineligible player is involved in only one men's/ladies doubles event then that event shall be the second men's/ladies doubles.
- (b) Team captains must complete their teams on both copies of the score sheet prior to the start of a match and both score sheets duly completed must be returned to the Cup and Shield secretary within 48 hours of the match.
- (a) All players in the competition shall be registered League members.
- (b) Not later than November 21 each year each club secretary must send to the Cups and Shields secretary a list, in quintuplicate, of players, not exceeding five men and five ladies, from which each team will be chosen.
- (c) No player shall be nominated for more than one team in the competition.
- (d) Any alterations in nominated teams must be approved by the League Executive.
- (e) No club may play a player whose nomination has not already been approved by the League Executive.
- Unless an authorised floater, any player having played during the current season three or more times for a team.
 - in the 1st or 2nd divisions shall be debarred from playing in the League Shield competition.
 - (ii) in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th divisions shall be debarred from playing in the St. John's Shield competition.

- 6. The order of play in all matches shall be in accordance with the requirements of the home team captain except in the final round when it shall be the responsibility of the official in charge of the match. No player shall have to play two events consecutively without a ten minutes break between.
- (a) If a player is injured during a match and is unable to continue, the score in the game in which the injury occurred shall:—
 - (i) if the game were completed, stand.
 - (ii) if the game were not completed, be recorded as a win for the opposing pair with the Injured playor's team being credited with the score at the time of Injury.
- (b) A substitute, if present at a match prior to 8.15 p.m. is eligible to replace an injured player. Such substitution will be direct, the substitute being assumed to be of equivalent standard to the injured player for the time of the match, and points scored by the substitute shall count to the team's advantage.
- (c) A team may replace an injured player with an ineligible player subject to the approval of the opposing captain. Such substitution shall be direct as in 7(b) above but all games involving the ineligible player shall be deemed to be lost with the ineligible player failing to score.
- (d) Once replaced by a substitute, an injured player shall not take part again in the match.
- 8. (a) Exceptionally an ineligible player may be played at 4th mixed doubles and 2nd men's/ladles doubles but the opposing team captain must be told prior to the start of the match.
- (b) The scores in each game shall count as 15-0 to the opposing team.
- (c) If an ineligible player is played other than as stated in 7(c) or 8 (a) then the match shall be forfeit to the opposing team.
 - 9. The executice committee shall:-
 - (a) arrange the venue for each final.
- (b) appoint a referee in each final who shall have full charge of each match.
- (c) deal with any matter not provided for in these regulations.
- (d) be the sole authority for the interpretation of these regulations.

REGULATIONS FOR THE HUDSON, HACKNEY, AND ST. PAULS CUP COMPETITIONS

- The competitions shall be played annually between teams in the Southport League on a knock-out basis and the League executive committee shall be responsible for the organisation, including seeding and the draw for each round.
- (a) Clubs, upon application before May 1 each year, may enter one team, to represent the club, in the Hudson Cup. Entry shall be free.
- (b) Teams in the second and lower divisions shall be given free entry to the Hackney and St. Pauls Cups competitions and the executive committee, at their first meeting each season, shall decide which divisions shall enter each competition.
- (a) Matches shall be played in a similar manner to League matches.
- (b) Team captains shall complete their teams on both copies of the score sheet prior to the start of the match and both score sheets duly completed must be returned by the winners to the Cup and Shield Secretary within 72 hours of the completion of the match otherwise the winners may be disqualified.
- (c) In the event of a tie on games, points shall count end, in the event of a tie on points, the match shall be replayed on the court of the team playing away in the original match. In the event of a further tie, the captains shall spin a coin to decide the choice of court for the next replay.
- 4. (a) All players in the competitions shall be registered League members.
- (n) No player may play in both the Hackney and St.
 Pauls Cups unless a registered floater approved by the League Executive.
- (c) No player may play for more than one team or more than one club in the Hackney and St. Pauls Cups.
- (a) The home team shall decide on which night during the appointed week the match shall be played.
- (b) The home team shall give at least 7 days written notice to the visiting team and advise their apponents which will be the first two events played.
- (c) All matches shall start at 7 p.m. unless mutually agreed otherwise.

7.-FINANCE

- A. The financial year of the League shall end on 31st March.
- Annual subscriptions shall be paid by 1st October in each League year.
- C. Any member whose subscription remains unpaid after 1st October in each year shall be liable to penalty, suspension, or forfeiture of membership at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- All monies due to the League shall be deemed to be owing to the League Hon, Treasurer.
- E. The rate of subscription shall be:-
 - (i) League entrance fee £2.00.
 - (ii) Annual subscription per club £2.00.
 - (iii) Private members annual subscription 20.25.
- F. The rate of registration shall be:-
 - (i) Bulk registration per team £1.25 plus whatever shall be the relevant insurance premium per registered player between the ages of 16 and 65.
 - (ii) Individual registration per player £0.25 to include any relevant insurance premium.
- Application to transfer fee £0.25.
- H. The League Accounts shall be audited within two months of the end of the financial year and shall be available for inspection upon request by any registered League member.
- A copy of the final accounts for the financial year just ended shall be produced at the Annual General Meeting and shall be suitably claused if not audited.

8.-APPEALS

Any club or player shall have the right to appeal to the Executive Committee on any matter and any such appeal or other application hereunder shall be deaft with in such manner as the Executive Committee may determine and their decision shall be final.

9.—RULES

Any matter not provided for by these rules shall be dealt with by the Executive Committee, who shall also be the sole authority for the interpretation thereof, provided that any decision given by a General Meeting shall be binding. Any addition to, or interpretation of, these rules made by the Executive Committee shall only be operative until the next Annual General Meeting of the League when they shall be reported to such meeting for confirmation or otherwise. No amendment or alteration to these rules shall be made except at a General Meeting.

6.-GENERAL MEETINGS

- (a) The Annual General Meeting of the League shall be held in the month of April on a day and at place and time appointed by the Executive Committee for the adoption of the Executive Committee report and final accounts, any alterations to rules, the election of officers and the Executive Committee as required under Rule 4, the election of the Hon. Auditor, and such other business as may be transacted in general meeting.
- (b) All items to be placed on the agenda of the Annual General Meeting, including nominations for office and for the Executive Committee, shall be sent in writing to the Hon. Gen. Secretary so as to reach him not later than 28th February in the same year.
- (c) Not less than 14 days notice of any general meeting shall be given. Written notification to each affiliated club secretary, which shall include the agenda for the meeting shall be deemed to be sufficient notice of the Annual General Meeting.
- (d) An Extraordinary General Meeting shall be convened upon a resolution of the League executive or at the written request to the Hon. Gen. Secretary of not less than 20 members being representative of at least 6 member clubs. Such requests shall state the purpose for which the meeting is required and no other business shall be transacted. The meeting shall be held within one month of such requisition being received by the Hon. Gen. Secretary and the notice and agends shall be circulated to all member club secretaries at least 14 days in advance.
- (e) Accidental emission to give the required notice to any Club Secretary shall not invalidate the proceedings at a general meeting.
- (f) All registered players of the League shall be entitled to attend and vote at any general meeting of the League.
- (g) Voting shall be by show of hands unless any 6 persons present, and entitled to vote, demand a ballot.
 - (h) No member may vote by proxy.
- (i) No Individual may have more than one vote, except the chairman of the meeting who shall have a casting vote.
- (j) At all General Meetings 20 members entitled to vote shall form a quorum.
 - (k) If there is no quorum for:-
 - (i) an Extraordinary General Meeting, the motion(s) on the agenda shall be deemed to have been defeated and the meeting concluded.
 - (ii) an Annual General Meeting, it shall be adjourned and another notification shall be circulated without a time restriction. At the adjourned meeting the members present shall form a quorum.

- (xvi) Registration fees shall accompany each registration form.
- (xvii) Any player having registered for one club and wishing to play in League matches for another club during the same season may apply to the Executive Committee for a transfer to the last mentioned club. A form of application to transfer must be purchased from the Hon. Match Secretary at a fee of 25p and must be duly completed and deposited with the Hon. Match Secretary not less than seven days before the first match in which the player intends to play for his or her new club. The player shall not play for the new club until he or she receives written notification from the Hon. Match Secretary that the transfer has been completed.
- (xviii) No club shall have the right to object to the registration of any player with another club except where the player is not clear on the books of the objecting club in respect of monies outstanding. Any club wishing to object under this clause must lodge such objection in writing, giving full particulars, with the League Secretary. The suppension by the Executive Committee of any registration under this rule shall be operative only until the defaulting player shall have discharged his or her obligations to the objecting club.

(xix) FLOATERS.

(a) Where a club has more than one team, whether in the same or different divisions, a player having played in a club team on more than one occasion is thereby debarred from playing in any lower ranked club team.

(b) However:-

- the Executive Committee may transfer such a player from one team to another on application being made for that purpose under 5.C. xvii, but only one trensfer shall ne allowed in a season in respect of such a player. Such transfer shall be free.
- 2. a Club shall have the right to nominate to the Executive Committee before 1st November the names of one lady and one gentieman from their lower team or from each of their lower teams and, upon being approved by the Executive Committee, these players shall not during that season be subject to the provisions of this rule. Such players shall be known as floaters and may only float up.

(c) The decision of the Executive Committee regarding any application under b.1. or nomination under b.2. above shall be final.

(d) Any club playing an ineligible player shall, at the discretion of the Executive Committee, forfelt all games and points won by that player while he or she was Ineligible.

CLUB TERMS

(vi) (a) All matches shall be played under the laws of badminton, and in the particular week appointed by the Executive Committee, unless written permission to re-arrange a match has been obtained from the Hon. Match Secretary,

(b) applications to re-arrange a match, glving full reasons therefor, must be in writing and delivered to the Hon, Match Secretary.

(vii) The home club shall have the sole right to decide on which right during the appointed week the match shall be played and shall give at least fourteen days written notice thereof to the visiting

(viii) All matches shall commence not later than 7 p.m. and the actual time of starting shall be marked

accurately on the score sheet.

(ix) The home club shall give fourteen days written notice to the visiting club of which events it desires to play at 7 p.m. and 7-15 p.m. respectively and it shall be the duty of each club to ensure that its players in such two events are available for play at the times stated.

(x) The order of play in all events shall be in accordance with the requirements of the home captain.

(xi) In the event of any delay arising in the commencement of any match the reason therefor shall be entered on the back of the score sheet and signed by both captains. In any such event the Executive Committee

 (a) may require both captains to appear before the Committee for the purpose of explaining

the delay.

(b) may impose on the club found to be at fault such fine or penalty as the committee may in their absolute discretion deem adequate.

(xii) No player selected to play in a particular match shall be eligible to play in the match unless he or she is present and ready to play by 8-15 p.m.

(xiii) If it shall appear to the Executive Committee that any player has habitually attended late for matches (as to which the Committee shall be the sole judges) the Committee shall have power to call the player before them and if they so decide:

 (a) to suspend the player from all League and other matches for such a period as the Committee may determine,

and for

(b) to impose upon the player such a fine as the Committeee may deem adequate.

(xiv) Nylon shuttles may be used in matches on giving 14 days prior notice and by mutual consent.

(xv) All players participating in League competitions must be registered with the League. For registration, each club secretary shall send on the form provided a list of club players to the Hon. Treasurer before the first match of each season. Additional players may be registered, on individual registration forms, within three days of participating in a match.

- (ii) Application for membership to the League for any year must be delivered in writing to the Hon. Gen. Secretary not later than the 30th day of April preceding the year concerned. First applications must be accompanied by the prescribed entrance
- (iii) An annual subscription shall be paid by each member club.

B. Structure

- The League shall consist of such one or more civisions as the Executive Committee shall determine.
- (ii) The Executive Committee shall form each division at its first meeting.

C. Competition

- (i) The team securing most points in each division shall be the champion team of that division and shall be entitled to the custody of the championship trophy of that division until the succeeding 30th April.
- (ii) The two teams at the head of the second and lower divisions shall be premoted to the next higher division, and the team or teams at the foot of each division may be relegated to the next lower division. This shall always apply except when the divisions are reconstituted by the Executive.
- (iii) In deciding questions of championship, promotion or relegation, where two or more teams secure the same number of points, the number of games won shall be the deciding factor.
- (iv) Each court shall have a minimum playing standard as decided by the Executive Committee.
- (v) (a) each match shall consist of four mixed doubles, two men's doubles, two tadles' doubles, and each event shall consist of two games of 15 aces. No player may play more than one like event in the same match.
 - (b) points shall be awarded as follows:-3 points for a win on games irrespective of ares.
 - 2 points for a tie on games and a win on aces 1 point for a tie on games and a tie on aces 1 point for a tie on games and a loss on oces.
 - (c) pairs must be played in order of strength,
 (d) captains must complete their teams on the match score sheet before the start of the match.
 - (e) In the event of any player being incapacitated, after play in a match has begun, so that he or she cannot continue playing, a captain shall be entitled to include a substitute in any subsequent games in which the incapacitated player should have taken part provided that the injury or other incapacity was caused entirely after play in the match had begun and was not due solely to tiredness or the wurseding of an existing allment.

(i) The officers of the League shall consist of: President

Chairman

Vice-Chairman Hon, General Secretary

Hon. Cup and Shield Secretary

Hon. Tournaments & Competitions Secretary

Hon. Tressurer

Hon. League Match Secretary Junior League Secretary & Press Officer

(ii) The officers shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

(iii) All retiring officers shall be oligible for re-

election.

(i) The Executive Committee shall have full power to transact the general business of the League.

(ii) The Executive Committee shall have power for-

(ii) The Executive Committee shall have power to: (a) co-opt not more than two additional members

to the Committee

(b) fill any casual vacancy occurring to the Committee, including a vacancy under Clause (iv) of this rule but anyone so appointed shall serve only until such time as the original member would have retired by rotation

(c) elect at any time any number of Vice-Presidents of the League, to hold office for such period as the Executive may determine.

(d) take any steps which they consider necessary for the purpose of enforcing payment of any subscription or fines payable or imposed under any rules for the time being of the League

(e) admit individuals to League membership

(f) elect Honorary Life Members

(g) appoint and delegate powers to sub-Committees for any purpose considered desirable and such sub-Committees may co-opt members to the sub-Committee from outside the Executive provided that the number of co-opted members is always less than the number of members of the Executive on the sub-Committee.

(iii) The Executive Committee shall meet not less than three times annually. Meetings shall be called at the discretion of the Chairman or at the request in writing of at least six members of the Executive.

(iv) If any member of the Executive Committee be absent from three consecutive Committee Meetings he may, at the discretion of the Executive Committee, be treated as having thereby tendered his resignation.

5.-THE LEAGUE

A. General

(i) The League year for which all officers and Committee members, whether elected, co-opted or substituted, shall hold office, and during which the membership and registration of all clubs and players shall subsist shall be from the first day of May in one year to the thirtieth of April in the following year.

SOUTHPORT AMATEUR BADMINTON LEAGUE R U L E S

1.-NAME

The League shall be called the Southport Amateur Badminton League. 2.—OBJECTS

The objects of the League shall be:-

(b) schools and Youth Associations whose member clubs have an age limit of 21 years. Such member clubs need not affiliate themselves directly, but unless so affiliated shall not be entitled to the privileges of affiliation.

(c) schools and Youth Clubs whose members have an age limit of 21 years

(d) individuals, known as private members, who shall: (i) pay an annual subscription

(ii) receive copies of all League circulars

(iii) be eligible to attend League general meetings

(iv) be eligible to vote and hold office

(a) Honorary Life Members. Individual members of individual clubs and associations are ipso facto indirect members of the League. 4.—ADMINISTRATION

(i) The management of the League shall be vested in an Executive Committee consisting of:-

(a) the officers of the League

(b) nine other members to be elected at the Annual General Meeting, three of whom shall retire each year in rotation.

(ii) Six members shall form a quorum at any committee meeting.

(III) All retiring members of the Committee shall be eligible for re-election.

(iv) The Officers of the League upon retirement from office shall be ex officio members of the Executive Committee for one year unless the Executive Committee shall otherwise decide.

(v) The Chairman shall have a casting vote at all meetings of the Executive.



- 6. (a) An inelegible player included in a team shall play either 3rd mixed and both men's/ladies doubles or 2nd men's/ladies doubles and 1st and 2nd mixed. Such three games involving an ineligible player with be considered to have been lost with the ineligible player having failed to score and his/her score will appear on the score sheet as the handicap to which the team played, e.g. 21 : minus 3, 21 : 0, 21 : plus 5.
- (b) If a team plays an ineligible player other than a stated in regulations 7 (c) or 8 (a) then that team shall forfer the match.
 - 9. The executive committee shall:---
 - (a) arrange the venue for each final.
- (b) appoint a referee in each final who shall have full charge of each match.
- (c) deal with any matter not provided for in these regulations.
- (d) be the sole authority for the interpretation of these regulations.

REGULATIONS FOR THE WATKINSON TROPHY COMPETITION

- The competition shall be played annually between all teams in the Southport League on a knock-out basis and the executive committee shall be responsible for the organisation, including the handicapping and draw for each round. Entry shall be free.
- (a) Matches shall be played in a similar manner to League matches.
- (b) All teams shall receive a points handloap, and scored points plus handloap points shall decide the winner. There shall be no setting.
- (c) Team captains shall complete their teams on both copies of the score sheet prior to the start of a match and both score sheets duly completed must be returned by the winners to the Cup and Shield Secretary within 72 hours of the completion of the match otherwise the winners may be disgualified.
- (d) In the event of a tie on points, games won shall not count and the match shall be replayed on the court of the team playing away in the original match. In the event of a further tie, the captains shall spin a coin to decide the choice of court for the next replay.
- (a) All players in the competition shall be registered League members.
- (b) No player shall play for more than one team in the competition unless an authorised floater approved by the League Executive.
- (c) Any player having played during the current season three or more times for a higher ranking team is not eligible to play in a lower ranking team unless an authorised floater.

- (a) The home team shall oiler their opponents two dates, at least 15 days apart from each other, upon which to play the match in such reasonable time as to permit their visitors to give at least 1 week's notice of acceptance of one of the dates,
- The home team shall advise their opponents which will be the first two events on court.
- All matches shall start at 7 p.m. unless mutually agreed otherwise.
- 5. The order of play in all matches shall be in accordance with the requirements of the home team captain except in the final round when it shall be the responsibility of the official in charge of the match. No player shall have to play two events consecutively without a ten minute break between.
- (a) If a player is injured during a match and is unable to continue, the score in the game in which the injury occurred shall:-
 - (i) if the game were completed, stand,

(ii) If the game were not completed, be recorded as a win for the opposing pair with the injured player's team being credited with the score at the time of injury.

(b) A substitute, if present at a match prior to 8.15 p.m. is eligible to replace an injured player. Such substitution will be direct, the substitute being assumed to be of equivalent standard to the injured player for the time of the match, and points scored by the substitute shall count to the team's advantage.

(c) A team may replace an injured player with an ineligible player subject to the approval of the opposing captain. Such substitution shall be direct as in 6 (b) above but all games involving the ineligible player shall be deemed to be lost with the ineligible player falling to

(d) Once replaced by a substitute, an injured player

shall not take part again in the match.

7. (a) Exceptionally an ineligible player may be played at 4th mixed doubles and 2nd men's/ladles doubles but the opposing team captain must be told prior to the start of the match.

(b) The scores in each game shall count as 15-0 to

the opposing team.

- (c) If an ineligible player is played other than as stated in 6 (c) or 7 (a) then the match shall be forfelt to the opposing team.
 - B. The executive committee shall:— (a) arrange the venue for the final.

(b) appoint a referee for the final who shall have full charge of each match.

(c) deal with any matter not provided for in these

regulations.

(d) be the sole authority for the interpretation of these regulations.

INDIVIDUAL TOURNAMENTS

REGULATIONS

1. (a) At its first meeting each season; the Executive Committee shall consider organising the following tournaments restricted to League members and veteran players who reside locally:-Tournament A — Open

Tournament B - Moderate Players

Handicap.

Tournament C - Restricted Moderate Players Handicap (restricted to moderate players in the third and lower divisions).

Tournament V - Veterans Handicap.

(b) Each tournament, unless decided otherwise by the Executive Committee, shall consist of:-

Men's singles Ladles' singles Men's doubles Ladies' doubles Mixed doubles

- All tournaments shall be run, as far as is practical, in accordance with the B.A. of E's regulations for tournaments and recommendations to tournament committees.
- 3. (a) All players registered with the League shall be eligible to enter the open tournament .
 - (b) Players shall be seeded in the open tournament.
 - (c) All players registered with the League shall be eligible to enter the Moderate Players Tournaments except those:-

(i) who have been awarded county colours

(ii) who, during the current or past season, have played on more than one occasion for a county first or second team.

but including past county players now authorised by the LCBA to take part in moderate players tournaments.

(d) Veteran competitors shall conform to the following criteria:-

(i) gentlemen: 45 years and over before

tournament closing date. 40 years and over before (II) ladles: tournament closing date.

- Entry shall be on forms obtainable from the Tournaments Secretary,
- Unless decided otherwise by the Executive Committee, matches shall consist of games of 15 aces (ladies' singles - 11 aces), the side first winning two games being the winner.

The Executive Committee:-

- (a) shall determine the entry fees per player per event; (b) shall determine the date by which entries, accompanied by entry fees, shall be in the hands of the Tournaments Secretary:
- (c) shall arrange the seeding, handicapping and draw;
- (d) shall direct when and where matches shall be played and the disposal of the results;
- (e) shall arrange the finals;
- (f) shall determine the prizes to be awarded;
- (g) may delegate their authority to such sub-committee as they see fit;
- (h) shall have the power to refuse the entry of anyone who, in its opinion, is too good a player for the "B" or "C" Tournament;
 - (i) shall have the power to cancel any event in the "B". "C" or "V" Tournaments If, in its opinion, the entry is not sufficient to warrant the event. Five
 - events shall be played in the "A" Tournament;
 (j) shall deal with any matter not provided for by
 these regulations and shall be the sole authority for the interpretation thereof.
