

This season the Southport 1st team finished third in the Littlewood Cup competition to Manchester and Liverpool and recorded victories over Barrow, Warrington, and Manchester II. The 2nd team, challenging for promotion at one stage, were eventually well beaten by Preston. With the three court Drill Hall now available, the town at last has a satisfactory venue for its matches and all home games should be played there this season.

Congratulations to Mrs. J. Pearson who was an ever present for Lancashire I during the season and to C. M. Hill and Mrs. V. Maxwell who both played regularly for Lancashire II.

In the Kearns trophy, Southbank Road reached the last eight before falling to the eventual winners.

The Hawks once again won the League Championship and the Amateurs completed their climb to the first division from the fourth in consecutive seasons, whist a revitalised Ainsdale swept all before them in the third division. Churchtown II met little opposition in the fourth division winning their matches very easily.

The Hudson Cup was once more successfully defended by the Hawks whiist Southbank Road again won the Hackney Cup in order to qualify for the challenge round of the Hudson Cup. The Amateurs proved too strong for the Panthers in the St. Paul's Cup Final which was played on one of the coldest, most miserable nights of the year.

There were some fine matches in the Fleetwood Hesketh Shield with the handicaps resulting in many close games. Southbank II played well to reach the final but disappointed against the all conquering Hawks. Ainsdale w.n an exciting final against All Sculs to take the League Shield although both clubs seemed a little off put by the wide open spaces of the Drill Hall.

With the advantage of a central venue and completion of events in one week, the individual tournaments were most successful and the size of the entry in the open as well as the handicap events augurs well for the future of these tournaments.

The League is pleased to see two further teams, St. Peter's III and Leyland Road III, from League members joining for the coming season and warmly welcomes two new clubs, Southport Teachers and Formby Methodist, to the League.



RULES

1.—(a) (i) All players registered with the League shall be eligible to enter the open competitions.

- (ii) Players shall be seeded in the Open Tournaments in accordance with the Rules of the Badminton Association of England.
- (b) All players registered with the League, except those who have been awarded County Colours or who during the current or past season have played on more than one occasion for a county first or second team. shall be eligible to enter the Moderate Players' (Handicap) Tournament.
- 2.—Entries must be in the hands of the Hon. Tou nament Secretary by dates fixed by the Executive Committee and must be made on entry forms obtained from the Han Tournament Secretary at a fee of 3/-d. or less per player.

Only one transfer shall be allowed during a season in respect of a player.

Provided that the club shall have the right to nominate to the Executive Committee before the thirty-first day of October the name of one lady and one gentleman and on such nominations being approved by the Executive Committee the players shall not, during that season, be subject to the provisions of this rule.

- (h) The decision of the Executive Committee regarding any nomination or application under (f) or (g) shall be final.
- (i) Any club playing an ineligible player shall, at the discretion of the Executive Committee, forfeit all games and points won by that player while he or she is ineligible.
- as owing to the League Treasurer.
- 16.—No amendment or alteration shall be made to these Rules except at a General Meeting of the League.

No amendment or alteration can be proposed as a resolution at an Extraordinary General Meeting of the League unless the Hon. General Secretary shall have written notice thereof seven days prior to the date fixed for the holding of such Extraordinary General Meeting.

- 12.—(a) The order of play in all even's shall be in accordance with the requirements of the home captain.
- (b) The home club shall give seven days' written notice to the visiting club of which events it desires to play at 7-00 p.m. and 7-15 p.m. respectively, and it shall be the duty of each club to ensure that its players in such two events are available for play at the times stated.
- (c) In the event of any delay arising in the commencement of any match the reason therefor shall be entered on the back of the score sheet and signed by both captains; and in any such event the Executive Committee shall have power to require both captains to appear before the Committee for the purpose of explaining the delay; and thereafter to impose on the club found to be at fault such fine or penalty as the Committee may in their absolute discretion deem adequate.
- 13.—(a) No player selected to play in a particular match shall be eligible to play in the match unless he or she is present and ready to play if required by 8-15 p.m.
- (b) If it shall appear to the Executive Committee that any player has habitually attended late for matches (as to which the Committee shall be the sole judges), the Committee shall have power to call the player before them and if they so decide—
- to suspend the player from all League and other matches for such a period as the Committee may determine; and/or
- (ii) to impose upon the player such fine as the Committee may deem adequate.

14.—(a) All players participating in League competitions must be registered with the League.

For registration, each Club Secretary shall send on the form provided, a list of club players to the Hon. Treasurer before the first match of each season.

Additional players may be registered, on individual registration forms, within three days of participating in a match.

- (b) Registration fees shall accompany each registration form as follows:—
- (i) Bulk Registration form at the rate of 25/- per team, plus whatever is the relevant Insurance premium per player (Senior or Junior) registered.
- (ii) Individual Registration form 5/- per Senior Play r and relevant Insurance premium per Junior Player.

- (c) The team securing the most points in each division shall be the champion team of that division and shall be entitled to the custody of the Championship Trophy of that division until the succeeding thirty-first day of March.
- (d) The team(s) at the head of the second and lower divisions shall be promoted to the next higher division, and the team(s) at the foot of the divisions may be relegated to the next lower division, as follows :-
- Where there are ten or more teams in a division two teams shall be promoted.
- (ii) Where there are less than ten teams in a division, one team shall be promoted.
- (e) In deciding questions of championship promotion or relegation, where two or more teams secure the same number of points the number of games won shall be the deciding factor.
- 9.—The minimum area of a playing court shall be 760 square feet, provided that no playing court shall be either less than 38 feet in length or 19 feet in width.
- 10.-(a) Each match shall consist of four mixed doubles, two men's doubles and two ladies doubles, and each event shall consist of two games of fifteen aces. No player may play more than one like event in the same match.
 - (b) Points shall be awarded as follows :--
 - 3 points for a win on games irrespective of ace. 2 points for a tie on games and a win on aces.
 - 1 point for a tie on games and a tie on accs.

- 11.—(a) All matches shall be played under the Laws of Badminton, and in the particular week appointed by the Executive Committee, unless written permission to re-arrange a match has been obtaned from the Hon. Match Secretary.
