## RECYCLING & DUMPING

**Boxes, Cartons, Glass, Cans**

As brown dumpsters are provided for household trash only, please be a great neighbor by breaking your boxes down and placing them in the **RECYCLING BINS** at the **FIRE STATION** on **LAZELLE ROAD**. This will leave space in the dumpsters for holiday waste in plastic trash bags.

Residents and their Contractors are prohibited from disposing of their building debris and associated bulk items, including furniture and used bedding, in brown dumpsters.



If you cannot wait for the quarterly BULK WEEKEND, please contact a Hauling Company to remove your bulk items. We provide the community with bulk weekend events to alleviate the misuse of our property's dumpsters.

**The next BULK WEEKEND is scheduled for December 28-29, 2024.**

### SMOKE ALARMS

Test that all smoke alarms are working. It is also a good idea to have a carbon monoxide detector & fire extinguisher in your home.

### WATER HOSES

## HOLIDAY SEASON REMINDERS

### NO PARKING ZONE

**Parking in Fire Lanes** (designated by **Yellow Lines** on the roads) is **PROHIBITED**. All Residents and holiday Guests are required to park in designated parking areas. **Vehicles parked in Fire Lanes will be towed without warning.**



### CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS

### CHRISTMAS TREE REMOVAL

### Christmas "Crackle" - Serves 12+

#### INGREDIENTS

3 cups Cheerios, 3 cups Rice Chex, 3 cups Wheat Chex, 1 cup Pretzel Sticks, 2-3 cups M&M's, 24 oz White Chocolate (plus an extra 4-8 oz if needed)

#### INSTRUCTIONS

1. In a large bowl combine the Cheerios, Chex, Pretzels and M&M's. Mix them up a bit, making sure that everything is evenly distributed.
2. Meanwhile, over a double boiler, melt the white chocolate according to the directions on the package.
3. Once the chocolate has melted and is a smooth consistency, drizzle the chocolate over the cereal mix and combine with a wooden spoon or hands. Make sure all the cereal is covered in chocolate. If you need to melt the extra white chocolate to cover all the mix then go right on ahead.
4. Once the entire batch has been combined, lay it out to dry on a large sheet of parchment or wax paper. Let dry for 1 hour so the chocolate is cooled and hard. Break it up into medium pieces and store in an airtight container in the fridge or freezer.
