These are only a few of the Many Activities which we All have missed out on this year. While we cannot live in the past, but we can look forward to a brighter tomorrow.


Let's All continue doing our part to support our Club and our Communities. As Commodore Dane McCoy said in his email earlier I am looking forward to returning to the EBC Board.




