The **Ebony Youth Foundation** is a charitable service organization that transforms donations into opportunities to improve the lives of students and to provide safety awareness training for the youth in the community. Many people and organizations donate to the Ebony Youth Foundation as their way to financially support scholarships being presented to qualified students and for our youth community service projects that we sponsor yearly.

**Donations to Ebony Youth Foundation supports the:**

**Scholarship Program Fund:** Education is a very important investment that never loses its value. The Foundation supports the excellence in obtaining a higher education. High school seniors or college students are eligible to apply for our Scholarship grants to help underwrite a portion of an aspiring scholar's school expenses in pursuit of a higher collegiate experience.

**Scholarship Expense Fund:** To recognize the scholars selected to receive the EYF scholarship at our yearly Change of Watch Inaugural Dinner. The expenses for their dinner and that of their parents will be covered by the Foundation. Any nominal expenses pertaining to the preparation for presentation for recognizing the scholars will also be covered.

**Youth Community Service Program Fund:** Three Youth Community Service based programs will be conducted yearly. Donations to help the Foundation to maintain these programs are always welcomed and encouraged from local Businesses, Organizations and through personal donations.

**Youth Community Service Program Expenses:** This fund supports the expenses associated with providing the three Youth Committee Service programs, such as lunch, program material and clerical expenses.

**EYF Administrative Expense Fund:** This fund supports the overall administrative expenses of the Foundation; such as stamps, envelopes and very basic overall Foundation operating expenses.

Donations may be made as a memorial or remembrance contribution. Donations may also be specified to one or more of the Funds listed above. When a donation is not designated to any particular Fund, the EYF Board then directs the contributions to where funding is most needed at that time. If insufficient donations are received for the Scholarship Expense Fund or the Youth Community Service Program Expense, the EYF will be limited in paying scholarship or youth community service program related expenses.
