Riders pay \$2 each way and must a reservation by 4:00 pm the previous day. Visit website to review service area. Hours of operation: 7:00 am - 7:00 pm Monday - Friday. The GoGeo service will end Sept. 30, 2026. After Aug. 15, 2026, CARTS will no longer accept applications for new GoGeo Riders. The City will continue to provide vouchers for curb-to-curb rides through Uber and Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles through the RideGTX program.

Fixed-route service is operated between the seven stations, and this service is available to anyone in the service area. CARTS also provides curb-to-curb service, also known as demand-response or on-call service, for mobility impaired individuals and individuals in need of special assistance in the CARTS service area. CARTS operates 60 mini-buses and vans to provide fixed-route and on-call services across Central Texas. You can view the schedule at RideCARTS.com

For zTrip issues, contact the ZTrip customer service center at 512-337-9796.	https://www.georgetowntxas.gov/transportation/transit/ridegtx.php	Uber riders get up to 10 discounted rides per month for rides (24/7) that start and end in the service area. Riders pay the first \$4, and the City subsidizes up to \$10 per ride. Riders pay any remaining balance over \$14. Ztrip riders (wheelchair accessible vehicles) get unlimited rides in the service area and also pay the first \$4 per trip. Rides that start and end in the service area are eligible for the discount. The service area includes the city limits of Georgetown plus Baylor Scott and White and Ascension Seton Williamson hospitals in Round Rock. On the Road Lending		https://ontheroadlending.org/	Offers affordable car loans, car search assistance and financial mentoring for moderate to low-income families. Must reside in Alabama, Georgia, Texas. Monthly take-home pay needs to be \$1,800 or above and have \$500 or more available in their monthly budget (after other living expenses) for car expenses (including car payment, insurance, and gas). Applicants will need to submit documentation online. This company considers a person's credit score but focuses on other factors when determining approval.
