Patients can select care based on the type of dental services they need, their availability for regularly scheduled appointments and the price point that fits their budget or dental insurance coverage. <u>Student Dental Clinic (Non-Emergency Procedures):</u> Cost: Rates are 60% to 70% lower than standard private practice prices. Requirements: Care is provided by dental students under faculty supervision. Because of this, appointments take longer (typically 3 to 4 hours per visit). Screening: New patients must first pay a \$50 fee for an initial screening appointment and X-rays to ensure their case is a good fit for student training. <u>Emergency Dental Clinic (Urgent Care):</u> If you are experiencing severe pain, infection, or a broken tooth, UT Dentistry offers urgent care appointments (typically scheduled within 24 to 48 hours). Important: Emergency care is provided during normal business hours (Monday–Friday, 7:30 AM–5:00 PM), not as a walk-in or 24/7 ER.
