What is Epiphany?

Epiphany is a 3 day weekend short course in Christianity for at risk youth and youth in the custody of DJJ. Subjects such as forgiveness, prayer, goal setting, the teachings of Christ, and living as a Christian in response to the life, death, and resurrection of Christ. The weekend is based on Cursillo, Walk to Emmaus, Kiros, Happening, and Chrysalis.

What does Epiphany do with these hearts?

The paper hearts are displayed throughout the weekend to decorate the conference room and serve as tangible signs that other Christians are praying for and thinking of the weekend's participants.

What should I put on the heart?

Please put your favorite Bible verse, simple drawings by a child, or a word of encouragement for the participants. You do not have to put your name on the heart. If you choose to, then list first name only.

How else can I support Epiphany?

One of the most important components of the weekend is that every hour of the weekend is covered by prayers by the Christian Community. In addition to the hearts, there is an opportunity to sign up to pray for the weekend - you pray from wherever you are at a time of your choosing.
