#### Council Highlights - July 13th Meeting

#### **Council Highlights:**

- Minutes were approved unanimously.
- Joyce Riley, who along with Ann Spainhour, led the Lenten/Easter program and shared the cost for all expenses, gave a recap of the program. She asked for financial assistance from various committees to help fund the 2025 Advent Proposal, which she shared with Council. The cost is estimated to be around \$300. This was approved unanimously by everyone present.
- A unanimous vote was taken to facilitate electric service in the park by Gregory Electric, to be in use by October for Halloween in the Park.

Positively Fit: Body, Mind and Soul

Positively Fit: Body, Mind and Soul

#### **Body: Chest**

Strong chest muscles are important if you are a body builder - they need strong bulging muscles - but chest muscles are just as important for everyone else. When your chest muscles are strong, they help you stand up straight and tall, improve posture, stabilize the shoulder which helps prevent injury, and helps us complete everyday activities. Think about how many times you push or pull a door or cabinet open and shut, or lift groceries or dishes on and off a shelf. Chest muscles are large muscles that we use more often than we think!

Here are a few exercises to keep your chest muscles strong for your everyday chores!

Push-ups—there are 3 ways to perform a push-up: on the floor on your toes, on the floor on your knees or standing a short distance from a wall. Lower your body by bending your elbows and slowly lower and lift your body. Try for 3 sets of 10. You can always start with fewer and work your way up!



Use a resistance band! Place the band around your back at shoulder level, hold the ends of the band in each hand and press your arms out straight. Try for 3 sets of 10.

Use the band in the same way to punch out alternating each side.

These are easy exercises that can be completed at home and will keep you pumping iron!



#### Mind:

Feeling strong and looking better is a boost of confidence! When we feel good, we have a more positive attitude. When we exercise, our body releases endorphins that give us a good feeling. These exercises can also give you a sense of accomplishment when you have completed your routine. Physical activity itself may improve cognitive function and reduce the risk of cognitive decline. Having strong muscles allows you to do the things that we have to do every day, as well as the things that we want to do for ourselves.
