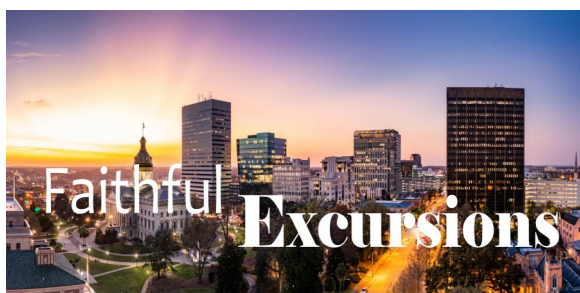

Dear Pastor Wade and members of Mt. Tabor,

Good morning! This weekend was an amazing Epiphany Weekend. I have been working with this ministry for over 25 years and this without a doubt was one of the best weekends I've seen. We had 10 boys aged 14-18 who were engaged and actively participated in all that was offered. We could truly feel the prayers of the community and the power of the Holy Spirit moving all weekend. We had a record number of hearts contributed to the weekend by the community making over 500 hearts. Mt. Tabor alone sent over 100 of those hearts - made by Beloved, Sing and Celebrate, and by Mt. Tabor members at the fellowship breakfast. Normally the kids love to see the hearts when we start hanging them up, but when they kept coming and coming, and coming out they were amazed by the quantity. We had enough to completely wrap our space 3 times over! Positively Fit: Body, Mind and Soul

We meet on Monday and Thursday at 5:30 in room 121, walking at 4:30. All ability levels are welcome! Variations of exercises are offered! Join our group. If you have questions, please ask Tammy O'Quinn, Brennen Hutto or Carol Busbee.

Let's compare mobility and flexibility again this month but focus on flexibility.

Flexibility: Passive Lengthening

- Definition: How far your muscles and tendons can stretch without resistance.
- How it works: Relies on gravity, external tools, or your own hands to pull/push a joint.
- Example: Using your hands to pull your knee to your chest while lying down.

Primary Focus: Muscle elasticity.

Mobility: Active Control

- Definition: The ability to move a joint freely and easily with coordination and stability.
- How it works: Requires active muscle engagement, strength, and nervous system control.
- Example: Lifting your leg unassisted as high as you can while standing.

Primary Focus: Joint health and functional movement.

It is important to remember that good mobility keeps joints moving but requires good flexibility of the muscles, ligaments and tendons. Last month we focused on exercises for mobility. These are good exercises to practice regularly. However, you need to incorporate flexible exercises too. If your muscles are tight, you may feel it is harder to move your joints. Because your joints feel tight, the muscles may tense up in response to the movement. Flexibility exercises are crucial for mobility.

The strength exercises from past articles are excellent for building strength. These strength exercises are great for increasing flexibility too. Yoga exercises like cat and cow stretch, side bends, calf stretches and child's pose build strength and increase flexibility.

The steps to good mobility are simple, daily gentle warm-ups and strength training. Know your limits and don't push your joints beyond your comfort zone. Always keep good posture which keeps your joint in line.

Here are a few exercises to improve flexibility. Perform the following exercises with slow and controlled movements. These are good warm-ups too!

Remember to use slow fluid movements and do daily mobility exercises!

Forward Fold - stand with feet hip width apart, tuck the chin, slowly rolled down toward the toes while the arms extend toward the toes. Hold for 30 seconds and slowly roll up. Repeat.

Toe on the Wall Calf Stretch - Stand facing a wall, stagger feet so that one foot is close to the wall, place the toes on the wall with the heel on the floor, move your weight to the front foot until you feel a stretch in the calf. Hold for 30 seconds then repeat on the other foot. Repeat the rounds.

Triceps Stretch - stand or sit, bend your elbow and reach your hand to touch the top and middle of your back. Place the other hand on your arm to hold in place and hold for 30 seconds then repeat on the other arm. Repeat the rounds.


Quad Stretch - Stand, you may want to hold the back of a chair or onto a wall, bend your knee and hold your foot with your hand. Hold the stretch for 30 seconds then repeat on the other leg. Repeat rounds.

Hip Adductor Stretch - Stand with feet wider than shoulder width, shift weight to one side bending the knee and keeping the other extended. Hold for 30 seconds then repeat on the other side. Repeat rounds.

There are many more stretches that you can try or take a yoga class!

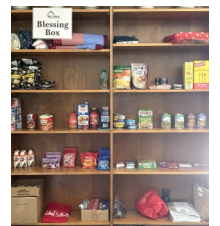

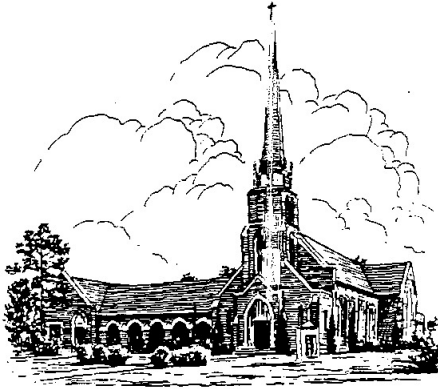
