Pastoral Ponderings

"I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now."

Phil 1:3-5

Mt Tabor, I thank my God for you, because of your sharing in the Gospel!

This time every year, we pack our bags, jump on the neighboring church bus, and head up the mountain to a place of Holy Ground called Lutherock. It's on the side of this mountain that God can be felt and experienced in ways that change our young folks' hearts and souls forever. I'm talking, of course, about Confirmation Camp (or Camp-firmation) at Lutherock with the cluster of sister churches from NC and SC. It's here we learn to pray, listen, and point to God showing up in the quiet of nature. It's here that God shows up in the fellowship of other young Lutherans walking trails together, roasting marshmallows together, and laughing together while making homemade ice cream. It is a place, that even the most introverted youth can be heard singing camp songs at the top of their lungs, and the most extroverted among us can find rest in the quiet of a tucked away corner of the cabin, reading their Bible for the first time. Only at Lutherock does God keep surprising us, healing us, and renewing us, each in just the way we needed it.

All this happens because you give generously to the mission of Mt. Tabor and support us going to camp each year. I cannot thank you enough for the extraordinary week you provide our young folks and the ways you support their faith formation. As we take this intentional time away every summer, your prayers and financial support go a long way in helping each of our youth learn more about their faith, trust deeper in their God, and grow in relationship with their pastor. This is a vital ministry of our church - one that shares the Gospel of Christ - with not only our beloved kids, but with people all around the southeast.

Thank you for continuing to see this camp and our experiences there as a worthwhile venture into the growth of our next generation. Thank you for investing in their faith, so that they may lead us and the church one day very soon. Keep sharing the Gospel, Mt Tabor, and keep on leading our youth to Jesus. Amen.

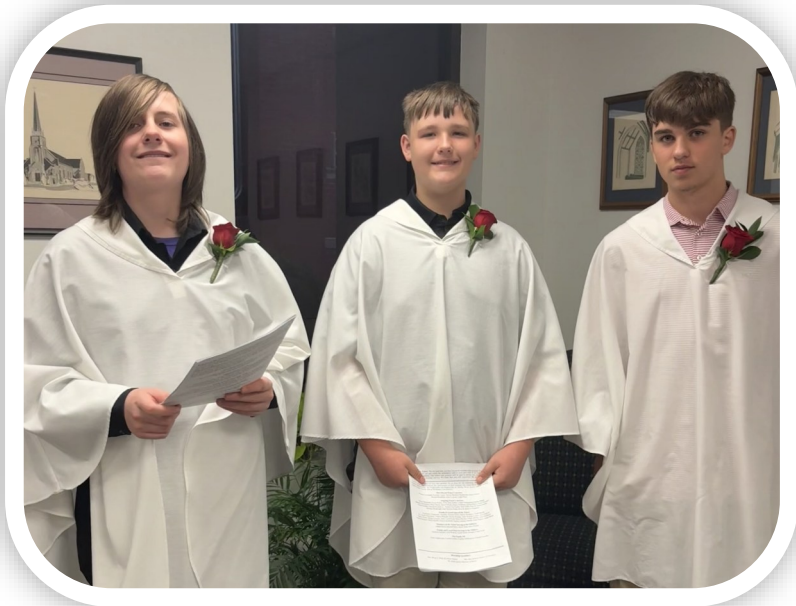

Positively Fit: Body, Mind and Soul

Body: Head and Neck

We never hear of an exercise program to strengthen our neck, but strong neck muscles can help to improve posture and stability, as well as, stability and support for the head. Exercise and stretch create better alignment of the neck reducing strain and stress on the spine. Training the neck muscles can correct imbalances from sitting for long periods of time and/or computer usage. Strong neck muscles have the potential to impact your voice and make your jaw line more defined. If you play an impact sport, strong neck muscles can help reduce injuries from impact. Some studies suggest that strong neck muscles may help with chronic neck pain.

If you have severe pain in the neck or any weakness in your arms or hands, you should immediately contact your doctor!

Some simple stretches can help strengthen the neck muscles and relief stress. Here are a few that you can try. Complete the stretches using *slow, easy* movements while sitting up straight in a chair.

Neck Tilt: Simply lower your chin to your chest, hold for 5 seconds then lift your chin. Do this for 5 reps.

Side to Side Tilt: Same as above but lower your ear toward your shoulder, hold and return to upright. Do this for 5 reps then repeat on the other side.

Neck Turn: Looking forward, turn your head to look over your shoulder keeping the chin level, hold for 5 seconds and return to facing forward. Do this for 5 reps then repeat looking over the opposite shoulder.

Forward Neck Stretch: Looking forward, slide your chin forward keeping your chin level, hold then return to neutral. Do this for 5 reps.

Other exercises that strengthen the neck are shoulder circles, shoulder shrugs, shoulder stretches, and the cat-cow stretch.

Mind:

Strong neck muscles can help cognitive impairments. They help to protect the head from injuries like concussions or traumatic brain injuries. Improved posture helps with focus and concentration which benefit cognition. Better head and neck movement help you to be aware of your surroundings, which is crucial for evaluation of your area. Strong neck muscles are important in everyday life, cognition, and a sense of well-being.

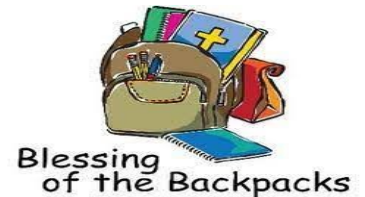

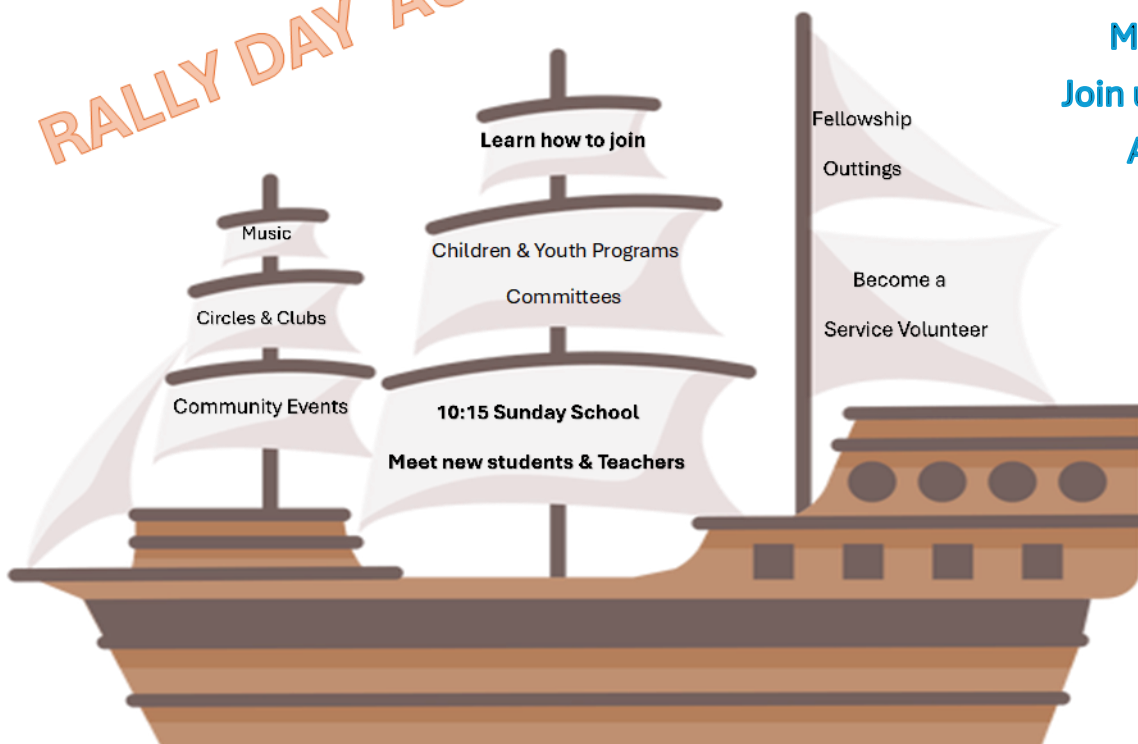

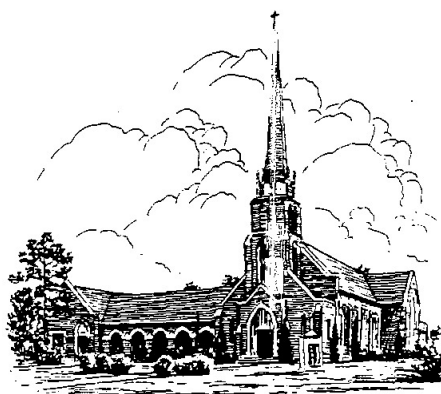
