

Are You Preparing for Lent?

In anticipation of Lent, we will be offering some ideas to help plan your Lenten activities. These will be in Wednesday snapchat and the Sunday announcements over the next two weeks.

Lent in A Bag kits will be distributed on Sunday, February 15th, in the Assembly Room, and will also be available at the Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper. This kit will have suggestions of disciplines and activities for individuals and families as we walk the 40 days of Lent.

Ash Wednesday is February 18th this year, just a short two weeks away! This day marks the beginning of Lent, 40 days of Reflection, Fasting and Penance. One of the most well-known traditions of this day is the imposition of ashes, to symbolize our mortality and the need for repentance, with the reminder to “Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.” The ashes used on Ash Wednesday are made by burning the previous year’s palm branches from our Palm Sunday services.

Consider attending one of our two Ash Wednesday services (12:00 noon or 7:00 PM) to receive the imposition of ashes.

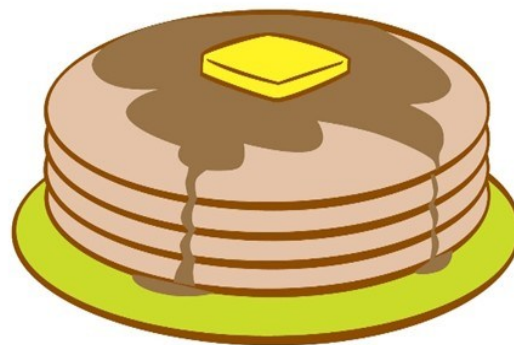
