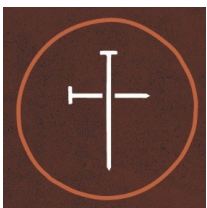

# Pastoral Ponderings

October 2024

*"The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make his face to shine upon you, and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up his countenance upon you, and give you peace."* Numbers 6:24-26

As of December 2024, The Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary will no longer call Columbia, South Carolina its home. Due to a myriad of circumstances, (both within and beyond the seminary's control - decline in student admissions and mounting debt that increased yearly), Lenoir Rhyne University decided to move Southern Seminary to its main campus in Hickory, NC. Fall of 2024 is the final semester for the Columbia Campus; once completed, the doors of the historic seminary will be closed forever.

As a graduate of this institution, as someone who was married in the chapel on campus, and whose first child was baptized in the font of this beautiful place, it pains me to see it go. While I realize that, at least at this point, this may be the seminary's only option to stay open, I will be sad. I am sad not only for me, but for the Church, the SC Synod, and for all of us who have enjoyed and benefited from its presence in South Carolina.

It occurred to me that even though it is in our own backyard, many of you have not experienced this holy and sacred place. Many of you have not had the pleasure or the opportunity to visit this historic and beautiful campus. If you don't visit soon, you may never have an opportunity to do so.

On October 13<sup>th</sup> at 10:30, Mt. Tabor Lutheran Church is going to give you both the pleasure and opportunity to come experience The Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary. We will host a congregational worship service at Southern Seminary. We want you to come and worship in Christ's Chapel. We want you all to walk the holy grounds of this historic campus and see where God has formed so many faithful people for ministry. We want you to experience God's presence and blessings, and we need your help as many of us say goodbye to something that has had so much influence in our lives, in our church and in churches all over the world.

The morning of Sunday, October 13<sup>th</sup>, Mt. Tabor will host Sunday school for all ages at 9:30, worship at 10:30, and after worship we will have a congregational lunch on the seminary grounds. Additionally, we are working on an opportunity to tour the buildings - if we are successful, the details of the tour will be in our announcements.

We want you there. We want this last opportunity to worship in this holy place to be a huge celebration of ministry, and a blessing of God's mission in theological education for years to come. Please, join us on October 13<sup>th</sup> at the Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary at 4201 North Main St. Columbia, SC, and let us give thanks to God for the blessings God gives us.

Positively Fit: Body', Mind and Soul

### Body:

The weather is starting to cool off a bit and it is a great time to get a little yard work completed. Instead of working out, you decide to get the yard spruced up. Use your yard as your gym!

If you have a push-behind lawn mower, use it as your gym equipment! Instead of just walking behind the lawn mower, add a few lunges as you push. As you step forward, bring the back knee down into a lunge, then up and repeat on the other side. You can mix it by doing two or three each leg and walking for a while then repeat. Try to get in 10 to 15 lunges on each leg. Use the mower to hold on to the handle and slip in a few calf raises as well. Come to a stop, raise up on your toes, back down and continue to mow. Try doing 5 then walking a few steps then 5 more.

Need to rake a few leaves? Use the rake as your gym equipment. Put the handle of the rake across your shoulders and hold on to each side with your hands. Rotate to the side then to the other side. This will work your obliques. Do the movement slowly and don't over rotate! Start with just a few on each side. While raking be sure to switch the rake from hand to hand - this will work your back and arms evenly.

Now that you have a large pile of leaves, do a few squats while cleaning up! Squat down and when you are low scoop up an armful of leaves to bag. You can even change it to a jump squat by jumping up with your armful of leaves. When your bags are full, use them to lift weights. Do a few overhead presses by lifting the bag of leaves up and push over your head. Do bicep curls by placing the bags on your forearms and roll the bag up to your chest and back down onto your arms.

Think of the exercises that you already do and incorporate them into your gardening activities. Remember be safe - use all gardening tools properly. Make sure that you are always balanced with any exercise. When standing or exercising keep your feet shoulder width apart to maintain balance. Keep your knees bent and back straight while lifting. Push up with your legs and not your back. When you lift, keep those bags and objects close to your body to prevent strain. When lifting and moving be careful not to twist or rotate, rather move your body around.

Take breaks to give your muscles a chance to recover, drink plenty of water, just as you would with any other work out, and listen to your body!

### Mind:

The sight of a beautiful garden can relieve stress. It can be as simple as a few pots of flowers on your patio or your entire yard. Sitting in nature can reduce stress and restore a positive mood. Sunlight provides your body with the ability to make vitamin D (the natural way) which can improve your mood. Fresh air and singing birds give an extra boost to the mood too. So, step outside, find a spot to make your sanctuary and enjoy nature!

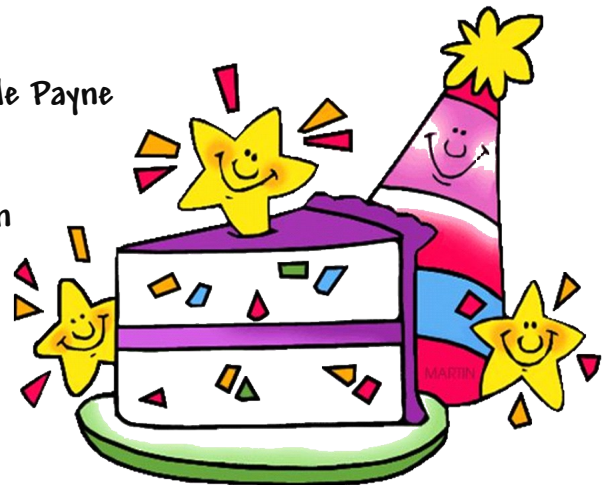

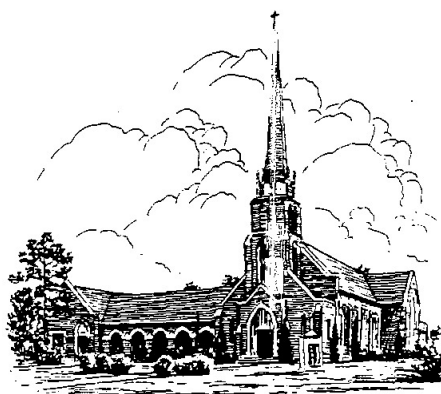
