## Pastoral Ponderings

*“Young people, rejoice while you are young, and let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth.” Ecclesiastes 11:9*

Many of you have heard me say this over the last two months, but THANK YOU! Thank you for your support of our youth and their faith formation. You have given generously to send our young folks to Confirmation Camp at Lutherock, to our Summer Youth Trip in Washington, DC, and to fund the youth ministry of this Church. We are grateful for your contributions to this ministry, and to the importance you put on raising them up as faithful young adults.

In June of every year, our rising 8<sup>th</sup> graders attend Confirmation Camp at Lutherock, in Newland, NC. This intentional week of retreat, in the mountains of North Carolina, brings together youth from six different congregations. They spend time studying God’s Word, listening and praying together, and enjoying the beautiful creation God has made. Our Confirmands come back from this trip changed people. This is valuable time in our middle schoolers’ lives. Thanks to each of you, the students participating and their families incur no cost to be a part of this amazing ministry.

Every two to three years, our senior high youth group takes a summer mission trip. The purpose of this trip is to engage in faithful learning, service opportunities, and worship experiences that truly change their lives. This past July, you helped send five of our senior high youth to experience God in Washington, DC. These young people learned how God helped free and shape this country to be what it is today. They served and fed the hungry and needy on the streets of DC, and even worshiped at the National Cathedral. Mt. Tabor partnered with youth from the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer in Charleston, SC and made deep, lifelong friendships with other Lutheran youth. We even had the chance to represent Mt. Tabor during the wreath-laying ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. This trip with our youth was the highlight of an already wonderful summer, and it couldn’t have happened without you.

Thank you for making youth ministry at Mt. Tabor a priority! Thank you for giving generously and consistently to help shape their lives, grow their faiths, and give them opportunities they may not have otherwise. Your love and giving hearts are felt and realized by our youth and they are grateful. I look forward to the youth coming up, and I am excited that they too will benefit for your love and support. We are all better because the ministry and mission of our youth group and the ways this congregation lifts them up.

May God bless you. May God continue to lead you to support this worthy ministry. And may God bless the youth of Mt. Tabor to be faithful servants in His kingdom. Amen

Body: How much exercise!

How much exercise is enough? According to the CDC, "regular physical activity is one of the most important things you can do for your health. Adults need at least 150 minutes of moderate-intensity physical activity each week. This could be 22 minutes every day, 30 minutes 5 days a week, or any other combination that works for you."

The CDC recommends "moderate intensity". This means any activity that gets you breathing harder and gets your heart beating faster. There are a wide range of activities from heavy gardening to walking, dancing, riding a bike and more! Any moderate-intensity activity adds up so try squeezing in a 5-minute brisk walk or dance several times a day or just go for a 30-minute brisk walk or jog. Everyone can find exercise that is just right for them. Exercise can range from marathon running to chair yoga. Just pick the exercise that you enjoy, make a schedule to make sure you get your exercise in and stick to your schedule. Find a friend to exercise with and hold each other accountable to meet and exercise!

Regular exercise has many benefits. It can improve sleep, lower the risk of diseases like heart disease and type 2 diabetes, lowers stress, improves energy levels and helps with weight loss. Exercising with a friend is important too! When you exercise with a friend, not only does it allow for fun and fellowship, it helps to keep you motivated.

Mind:

Exercise causes your brain to release chemicals called endorphins and serotonin that cause you to feel good. It helps to lift your spirits and improve your mood. Exercise can be a good distraction from stress and negative thoughts. Regular exercise improves us physically and mentally!

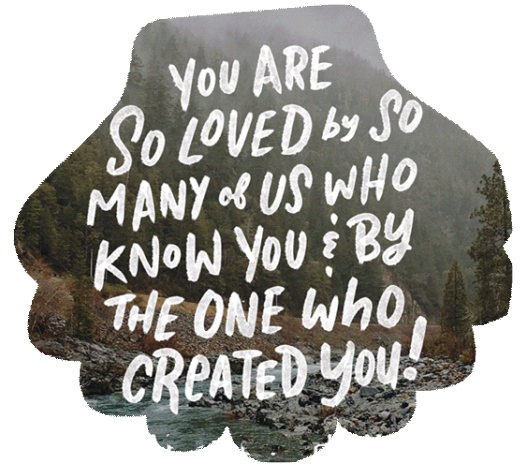

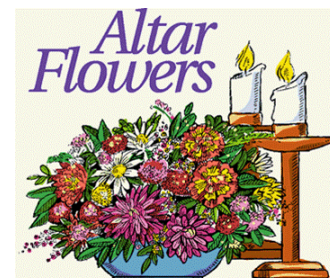

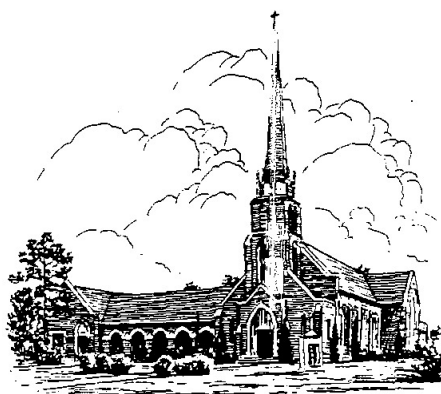
