Council Meeting

The next scheduled Council meeting will be Sunday, August 8, at 6:00 PM in the Easley Conference Room.



Travis Spainhour, President, introduced Bishop Ginny Aebischer to Council. She met with Council to discuss the Call Process for finding an associate pastor. The first step is to fill out a Ministry Site Profile at the ELCA website and send this to her. Council will finalize the document. Council agreed that we are looking for a Word & Sacrament Associate Pastor, not a Deacon (who cannot serve Communion). She will send the 3 best matches for Mt. Tabor. Pastor Wade Roof can sit on the Call Committee but is not a member of the Call Committee. According to our Constitution, the Call Committee will consist of 5 members from an assortment of members: young, old, male, female, etc. The first meeting with candidates can be on ZOOM. Bishop Aebischer will send a transition package with devotions and suggestions for the Call Committee. Once the Call Committee decides on a candidate, Council can meet with the candidate for questions. The Finance Committee will need to meet to discuss compensation. Pastor Wade can also meet with candidate for his personal input over coffee. If Council and Pastor Wade agree on the candidate, the candidate will be offered the package and if he approves of the compensation, the congregation will be sent bio information and will come together for a Meet and Greet with candidate. The congregational vote will follow with at least 2/3 or greater agreeing to call the pastor. A vote will also be taken for agreement with compensation with 50% or better.

From Our Vicar

As my time here at Mt. Tabor ends, I've been thinking about time. We measure our lives in time. Time is the means by which we base our lives. It is, as Merriam Webster defines, "a nonspatial continuum that is measured in terms of events which succeed one another from past through present to future." It infiltrates our language and our lives. It's something we wish we had more of at times yet at other times, it lasts too long. For example, internship is the last part of my journey as a *seminary student* after which I will begin a new journey as an ordained pastor in a church. Some of you know my story - that it has taken me 28 years to get to this point once my seminary journey began in 1993. That's a *very* long time! When I first got here, waiting even one more year seemed interminable! It seemed like the year would never end so that I could move on to the next part of my journey for which I had waited so long. Waiting in anticipation has a habit of making time seem relentlessly endless, doesn't it? On the other hand, now that my internship with Mt. Tabor is coming to an end, I wish I had more time here; more time to get to know those of you I have not had the pleasure to know, more time to hear your stories, more time to love and serve you, more time to live among you.

Time marches on, however and things change. It is the way of life. According to Ecclesiastes 3:1-8, everything has its time. "For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven: a time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted; a time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up; a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance; a time to throw away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing; a time to seek, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to throw away; a time to tear, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak; a time to love, and a time to hate; a time for war, and a time for peace."

And indeed, there is a season and a time for everything. An ending becomes a new beginning. But that new beginning happens only because that which ended has allowed it to. My new beginning will be to become an ordained pastor in a church somewhere in Florida. But this has been made possible only because of the love and care you have given me during my time at Mt. Tabor. The time you have given me to help mold and shape me into the pastor I will be, has been invaluable. It is time that I wish I could save in a bottle and take out and relive as time goes by. In other words, it is time I will not soon, if ever, forget and for which I will always be grateful. This is my time to be plucked up from where I have been planted over the last year. It is a time that in my seeking to continue my journey, I must lose the security I have found in this congregation. But it is because of the peace and security you have given me that I know I am ready to continue. I will take with me all that I have learned from you. I will take the friendships that have been made that will continue for the rest of my time. I will also take the love I have been given and will hold it in my heart for all time.

My heartfelt gratitude and thanks I give to you, people of Mt. Tabor. You are indeed a blessing not only to me but also to the larger church and to all who pass through your doors.

Discipleship Ponderings




