

Any excess money after the renovation will be donated to scholarship funds at Newberry College and/or Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary." This project has been discussed with Mt. Tabor members of the Easley family. Any memorials to Mt. Tabor already given may be reassigned to this project by the donor contacting the church office.
