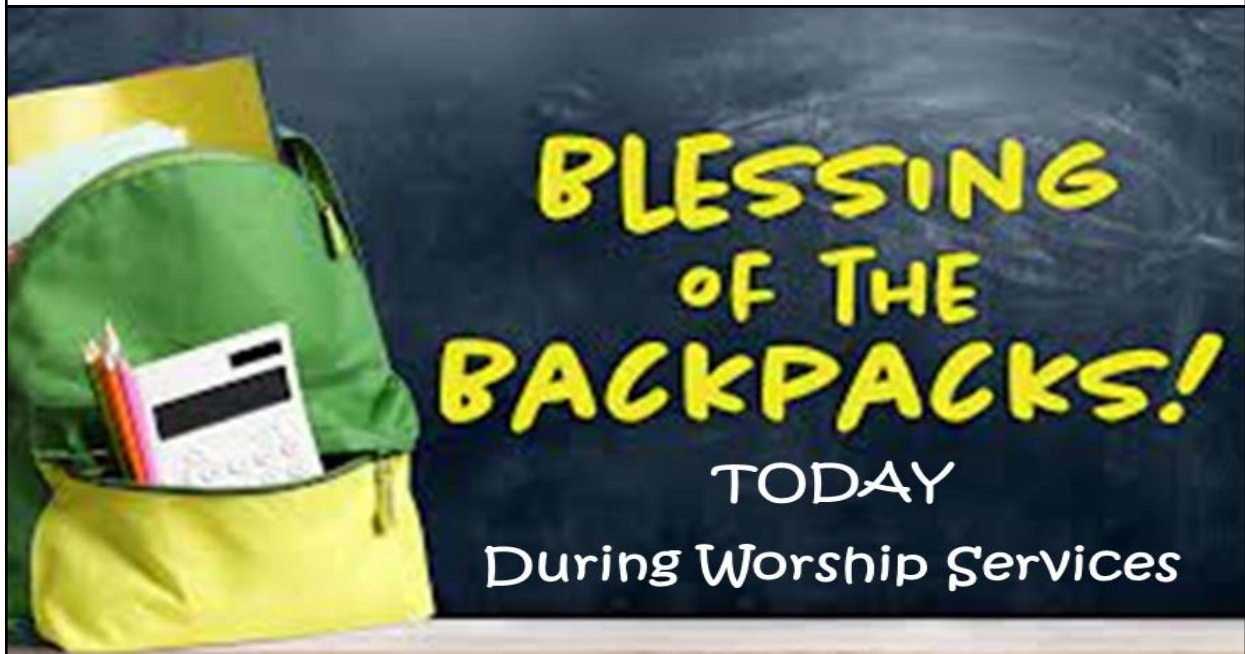

## Easley Conference Room Renovations

The Easley Conference Room (ECR) has been used for many functions over the years, especially as a result of the pandemic and the recent fire. This increased use helped us identify the need for a project to update and renovate the ECR and adjacent hall restrooms. The following motion was made and approved unanimously by our Church Council: "For memorials given to the General Fund in memory of Pastor Charles Easley to be used to help renovate the ECR, including the small kitchen area and adjacent restrooms. Any excess money after the renovation will be donated to scholarship funds at Newberry College and/or Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary." This project has been discussed with Mt. Tabor members of the Easley family. Any memorials to Mt. Tabor already given may be reassigned to this project by the donor contacting the church office.
