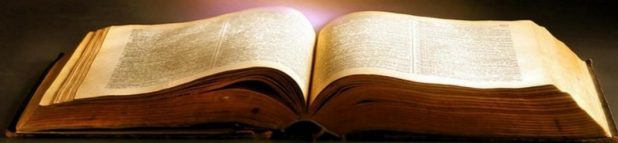


Receiving New Members

Updated Mask Policy at Mt. Tabor

Due to the City of West Columbia Mask Ordinance that was put into place this past week, we ask that you please wear a face mask while in all areas of this facility and continue to practice appropriate social distancing.

A Face Covering shall not be required:

- ♦ by any person who is unable to safely wear a Face Covering due to age or an underlying health condition;
- ♦ by any person who is physically unable to remove the Face Covering without the assistance of others;
- ♦ by all persons under two (2) years of age;
- ♦ all persons whose religious beliefs prevent them from wearing a Face Covering;
- ♦ any person in a private or individual office;
- ♦ where it is not feasible or medically practical to wear a Face Covering, including persons receiving oral health services, persons swimming or engaging in athletic activities;
- ♦ for patrons of Foodservice Establishments while they are eating, drinking or smoking (where permitted);
- ♦ and by police officers, fire fighters and other first responders when not practical or engaged in a public safety matter of an emergency nature.
