The HUGS program is alive and well at Mt. Tabor! We continue to provide support to our partners in the trenches! Their mission of ministering to our homeless brothers and sisters every day has become our call as well. Through God's guidance, and your generous donations last fall, we have been able to provide the numerous organizations with grants from HUGS. During August and September of 2023 the following received monetary funds to help fund their mission:

Candyman Homeless Outreach \$1500 for Sleeping Bags and clothing.

Mental Illness Recovery Center Inc. provided backpacks and food to their clients who were going back to school. We also helped stock their clothing closet for winter. \$2,500.

WSUMC Soun Cellar \$241 to provide 400 rain populos.

Brookland Cayce and Airport High Schools Families in Transition (each school has about 25 homeless students). We provided \$1,000 to each school. These donations will provide food and school supplies.

HANES provided men's and women's hoodies, underwear and socks divided among our partners at MIRCI, Transitional Retreat and Candyman Homeless Outreach.

In addition, 60 quilts, made with love by Mt. Tabor Quilting Ministry will greet new residents at Christ Central Ministries Transitional Retreat when the residents arrive in October.

Since 2018, HUGS has embraced the Midlands Homeless with 2,800 Hats, 4,500 pieces of underwear, 2,600 pairs of gloves, 6,300 pairs of socks, 1,000 hoodies, 385 sleeping bags, 1500 masks and hundreds of other items to help with ministry to the homeless.
