A Note From Our Vicar

And Mary said, "My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior" (Luke 1:46-47)

Happy Advent! As I write this, we are diligently preparing for Advent festivities here at Mt. Tabor. I've spent the day assembling activities for Sunday School kids, writing devotions, and being assigned a role in the upcoming Children's Play! Advent is the season of preparation, when we are waiting and hoping for Jesus' birth on Christmas Eve.

The above Bible verse is from my favorite Gospel passage, the story of Mary visiting Elizabeth when they are both expecting. I imagine Mary, a young and scared girl, not yet even a married woman, needing some accompaniment. And I imagine Elizabeth, an old woman, who had long given up hope of a child, also feeling scared and in need of a friend. So, these two women, beloved and chosen by God, nervous and hopeful, they live together for three months.

When Mary (and Jesus) enter the room, Elizabeth exclaims that her baby (John the Baptist) leaps in her womb. And in the midst of all the chaos that these two pregnancies bring to these ladies' lives, they praise God. They sing the praises of their Creator and thank Him for blessing them beyond their wildest dreams. They prepare for the birth of their babies together.

I hope that we too, in the midst of the chaos of our lives, will make time in this Advent season to sing the praises of God our Creator. Amid the craziness of Christmas shopping and school programs and work deadlines, may we make time to accompany one another on this journey—just as Mary and Elizabeth did for one another. Let us prepare for the birth of Jesus together!

This Advent season at Mt. Tabor, there are an abundance of opportunities to join in and do just that. November 28th brings the first Sunday of Advent—with a congregational meeting at 10:30 and a bag of Advent activities handed out to Sunday School children. In these bags, each child will receive the materials to make their own advent wreath, and a deck of cards to read one card each night at dinner. The cards contain either a Bible verse, prayer, or activity for that day, in preparation for Christmas.

Our December calendar at Mt. Tabor is filled with festivities! The second Sunday of Advent (Dec. 5th) will feature the Children's Christmas Program during the 11:00 Traditional Service. The following Saturday (Dec. 11th), our youth will be walking in the Cayce Parade of Lights. The third Sunday of Advent (Dec. 12th) will bring the afternoon Christmas Concert. Our Live Nativity will take place on the church lawn on the fourth Sunday (Dec. 19th). All of this leads up to our Christmas Eve services at 5:00 PM, 7:00 PM, and 11:00 PM.

Let's rejoice, sing the praises of God our Savior, and prepare for Christmas together. Join us this Ad-

vent season at Mt. Tabor!


