Ponderings from our Vicar

Happy New Year! 2020, a year we will never forget, is finally gone. Time to shout "Jumanji!" and reset our lives to move towards some semblance of normalcy. Good riddance, 2020! Don't let the door hit you on your back end as you leave ... or maybe do!

Yes, 2021 is here. With this new year comes a new beginning of hope. Hope for normalcy, hope for unity, but most of all, hope for the holistic healing of our nation, our church, and each other. Now is the time for renewed hope and renewed strength – hope and strength that we find in God who holds and sustains us; hope and strength to be renewed to reach out to our neighbors and to care for one another.

It is in this trust in God's faithfulness that a Faith Community Health Ministry is being initiated at Mt. Tabor. This programmatic approach to care and support seeks to nurture and encourage members of our congregation toward healthy lives in mind, body, and soul. A task force has been established to investigate ways in which this ministry can be established at Mt. Tabor in order to provide for the holistic needs of our faith community.

While hiring a part-time or full-time staff nurse for this ministry would be nice and something for which to hope one day, we look for volunteers who would like to participate in the mission of this ministry from our congregation to provide holistic care and education to members of Mt. Tabor. Previous experience in the health field is not required. All that is necessary is a love of neighbor and a desire to help.

It is in this effort that you will soon receive a short survey that we hope you will complete and return to Mt. Tabor. This survey of six or so questions will help focus the direction of the Faith Community Health Ministry. It will also allow us to identify and include those of you who would like to participate in this ministry. There are four ways in which you can complete this survey and return it to Mt. Tabor – via email, Internet (Survey Monkey), or US Postal mail. A fourth way is to complete it when you are at church and return it to one of the ushers.

Jesus said that the greatest commandment is to love God with all our hearts, our souls, and our minds. He also said that a second that is like it is to love our neighbors as ourselves. Loving our neighbors as ourselves is the way in which we love God with all our hearts, souls, and minds. The Faith Community Health Ministry is one way in which we love God.

Faith over Fear in the New Year!!!! We never expected anything that happened in 2020 and to be honest, we were always expecting the unexpected. There was no certainty about anything and there were many times that we were all fearful. As we begin 2021, those fears are

still with us and with good reason. We are still amid a pandemic, but COVID is not what defines who we are or whose we are. We are children of God and people of Faith!!! Next Steps for In-Person Worship & Events

Worship: The 11:00am worship time will be our singing service. It is the last worship service of the day and the Sanctuary will be cleaned thoroughly afterwards. The traditional service is normally at 11:00. So, to give both the traditional service and the contemporary service people a chance to sing as a gathered congregation, we plan to alternate those worship services to accommodate each service.

Nursery: The Nursery will be opened as needed during the 9:35am service. The nursery, toys, and furniture will be cleaned thoroughly after every use. Children between the ages of 0-4 will be dropped off at the education doors on B Ave, and walked to the nursery by an adult volunteer. Pick up will happen at the same door following the worship service that you were a part of. Drop off 9:15 – 9:30am, and pickup 10:30 – 10:45am for the traditional service. Nursery will be available beginning on 12/20/20. Please RSVP to the church office if you plan on using the nursery each week.

Children's Ministry: On Sunday each week, Sunday School will be offered for anyone from 5th grade and below. Sunday School will be available during the 11:00 Worship Service. Drop off between 10:45 – 11:00am and pickup between 11:50am – 12:15pm. Sunday School will begin on 1/10/21.




