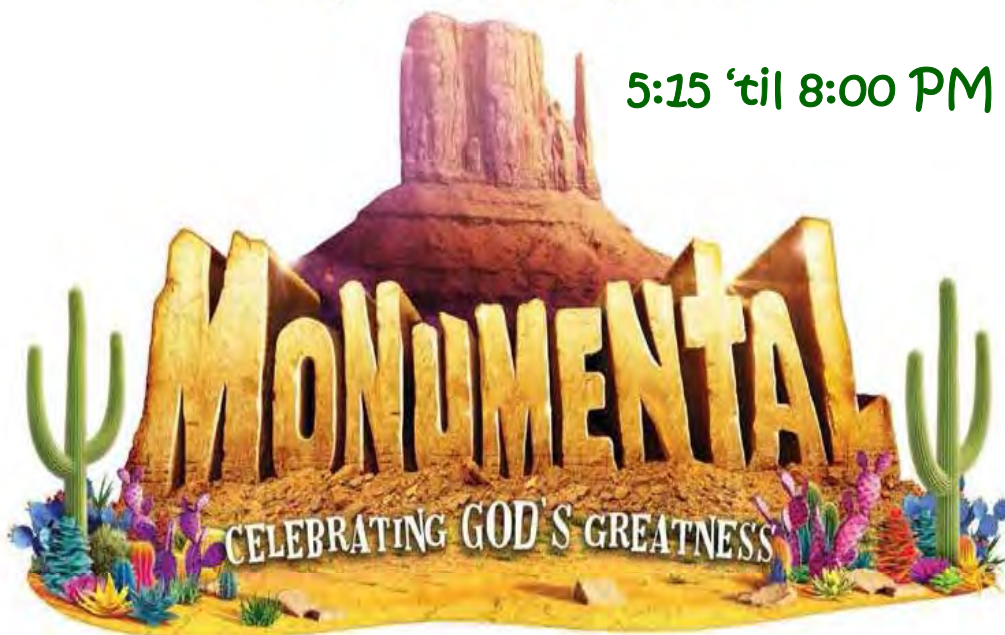

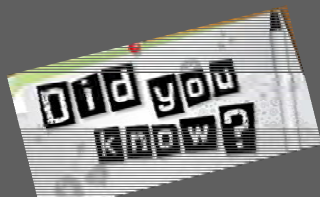

Council Highlights

Nothing to report at this time.

Easley Conference Room Renovations

The Easley Conference Room (ECR) has been used for many functions, such as dressing children for the Christmas pageant, storing choir robes, Bible study, youth functions, Sunshine Club, ladies circle groups, council and committee meetings, especially as a result of the pandemic and the recent fire. This increased use helped us identify the need for a project to update and renovate the ECR and adjacent hall restrooms. A motion was made at Church Council meeting Sunday: "For memorials given to the General Fund in memory of Pastor Charles Easley to be used to help renovate the ECR, including the small kitchen area and adjacent restrooms. Any excess money after the renovation will be donated to scholarship funds at Newberry College and/or Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary." The motion was approved unanimously. This project has been discussed with Mt. Tabor members of the Easley family. Any memorials to Mt. Tabor already given may be reassigned to this project by the donor contacting Stella McGee or the church office.

FROM OUR VICAR

“God is like a gardener,” is a phrase I have heard repeatedly at seminary. As an Iowa girl, this is an image I really resonate with. From an early age, I have memories of planting with my mom in our flower beds. We’d dig our hands into rich black soil, planting flowers and bushes, and spreading mulch and grass seed. We’d sprinkle fertilizer and hope for rain to come. We’d spend hours, watering and pruning and plucking up weeds. My mother, with her beautiful voice, would often sing as we planted. Through spring, summer, and fall, we’d rejoice when beautiful blooms would open, or new growth would appear. Hoping and waiting, and caretaking in the garden.

The creation story we find in the second chapter of Genesis, shows us an image of God—intimately caretaking in the garden. The Lord God forms humankind from the earth and breathes life into this first person’s nostrils. The Hebrew word for dirt, is Adamah. God scoops up dirt, forms a person, breathes life into him, and names him “Adam.” From the dust we are created, and to dust we shall someday return.

And then, in the next verses, we see God plant a garden, and place the man into this garden. God tills the soil, helps the trees and plants grow. God provides flowing water, and names the rivers. God creates another human, a partner, for Adam, and names her Eve. As we read on in the story, we get beautiful imagery, of the Lord God walking in the garden—seeking out God’s people and speaking to them. God gives them guidelines, commandments to follow in this kingdom. Soon, we know that God will send them out, into the wider world.

We still, have a God who is intimately caretaking in this world. Like the first of humankind, we, too, live amongst God’s creation and are called to be its stewards. God names us, pours water over us, walks among us. All that is in this world belongs to God, we are merely stewards of His earth.

Last fall, a community group called Brickyard Branch Watershed Association, planted several trees in our Mt. Tabor Park. Pastor Wade, along with members of the community, prayed over the new growth, and blessed the sacred work of planting and tilling God’s earth. They have been planting native trees, grasses, and shrubs all over Cayce and West Columbia, and they are excited to continue investing in our local ecosystem. You can find the growing seedlings with fresh pine straw all around the Mt. Tabor Park. This group is working with MTLC members and staff to plan more planting next fall, both in the park and the surrounding church owned lots.

Taking care of God’s earth is holy work. God is like a gardener: planting, pruning, watering God’s creation. And if we are made in God’s image, then surely, we too, are called to follow in these footsteps. A gardener intimately knows her garden. A gardener spends time with the soil, hopes for growth, provides care and nutrients. God does this for us and calls us to do this for the earth.

Lincoln Pipe Organs has done a tremendous job. In the coming weeks, they will tune our instrument. I put off our spring tuning knowing that the repair work would be completed in early summer.

Continuing Education

I will be participating in two continuing education programs this summer. The first, July 12-17, will be a Royal School of Church Music Course for Girls and Adults held at Duke University. The RSCM is an ecumenical organization that supports choir training/music lessons beginning in early elementary grades. The second course will be a Liturgical Arts Festival held at the Lutheran Seminary here in Columbia. It will feature organists Eric Plutz and Peter Sykes in recitals and master classes. It will culminate in a service that area choirs (including ours) are invited to participate.

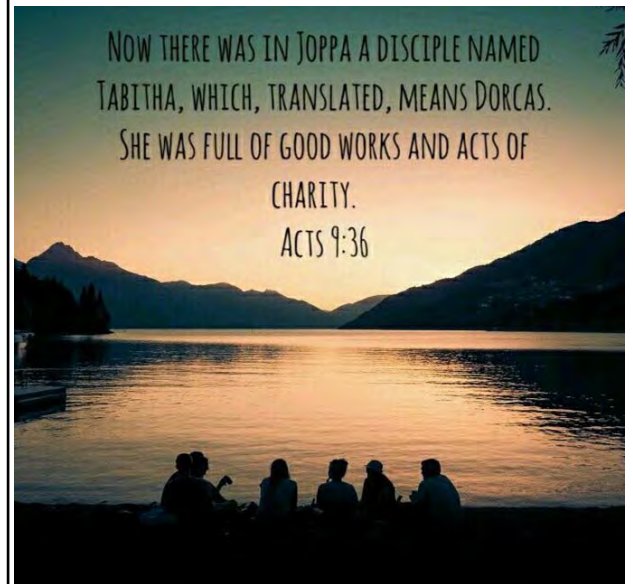
