

#### **Council Meeting**

The next scheduled Council meeting will be Sunday, November 8, at 6:00 PM.



#### **Votes Taken:**

- Minutes from the September 13, 2020 Council Meeting were unanimously approved. Minutes from October 1, 2020 Called Council Meeting were amended and approved unanimously.
- •Todd Sease, Finance Chairperson, presented the 2021 Proposed Budget which was approved unanimously after discussion. The 2021 Proposed Budget and Council nominees will be discussed at a Congregational Meeting on November 22. This meeting will be held after the 8:15 AM service and before the 10:00 AM service. There will only be two services that day. The vote for the 2021 Proposed Budget and Council will be taken at a Congregational Meeting to be held December 6 at the same time.

Each person has taught me something and shared with me a part of who they are. I know whose they are by their words and their actions – by their love and caring. This is you, Mt. Tabor. This is who you are – people of God – you who are running this race with me, who I know will pick me up if (when?) I fall, help brush me off, and set me back on my journey sharing your knowledge and offering encouragement and support along the way.

Thank you for making this beginning so easy. I look forward to the remaining ten months with you and to a time that I can say, I've run the good race with my brothers and sisters in Christ and I have not reached the finish line but I have been made ready for the longer distance. However, not too quickly. There's work and re-forming to be done. So right now, I will say I look forward to this time of growing into my call, my faith, and my relationships with you.




#### **Early Risers Prayer Breakfast**






