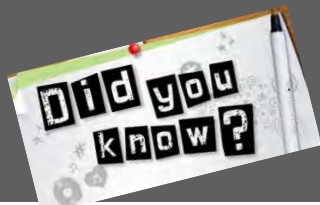

Pastoral Ponderings

"Like good stewards of the manifold grace of God, serve one another with whatever gift each of you has received." ~1 Peter 4:10

As we leave the month of October, we leave our stewardship focused - mission moments, but we don't leave behind the idea that we are called to be good stewards of all that God has given us. In fact, we keep in the forefront of our minds and hearts, that "Stewardship" is everything we do after we say that we believe in Jesus Christ. After all, God has given us everything that we have and everything that we are, and we are called not just to manage it, but to be generous with our time, talents, and treasures so that we might witness to the generosity of God, and to the abundant life that God gives to each one of us. Each time we are generous with what God first gave us, we testify to our belief that God will continue to pour out His blessings on us, and that the source from which these blessings come, have no end for God's people.

So, as we enter into the month of November, we do so in great thanksgiving to our God and Father, for all that we have and all that we are. Reformation Sunday

Reformation Sunday will be a special celebration this year with a brass quartet (Tony and Colin Roebuck on trumpet, Emily and MaryLou Schweickert on horn and Trombone) and timpani (Scott Herring). The choir will sing two anthems. "God is our Refuge" by Allen Pote will be sung in place of Psalm 46 and the Offertory Anthem will be "Thy Word" arranged by Jack Schrader. We will also use the festival setting of the Communion Liturgy by John Ferguson. The Mt. Tabor Ringers will be featured for the Prelude.

Christmas Concert

The Christmas Concert will be held on December 12. We hope to include all ensembles of Mt. Tabor and include brass and timpani. Over the next several weeks the Worship and Music Committee will discuss the logistics of the concert being held during the Pandemic and giving the Council a plan with a potential plan (or 2!) that we hope won't be needed! Please mark your calendars.

Music Stand Cart

We have about 20 music stands and are lacking storage in which to put them as they take up a lot of area without a proper way to store them. There are several styles of carts that would store them in a more orderly fashion and also allow for them to be moved. In all cases the carts allow the stands to "nest" together in a way that isn't possible without the cart. The cost would be under \$500. This is another addition to the Music wish list.

Organ

The organ needs some repairs to the keyboards to fix dead notes. We have now received an estimate of about \$11,000 to \$12,000 for the repair work to be completed. Currently, I am limited as to what music may be played on the organ (including hymns and anthems). We are currently accepting donations towards the repair of the organ. Please note that we will not be able to have the repair work finished until early in 2022 due to the schedule of the Randall Dyer Organ Company.

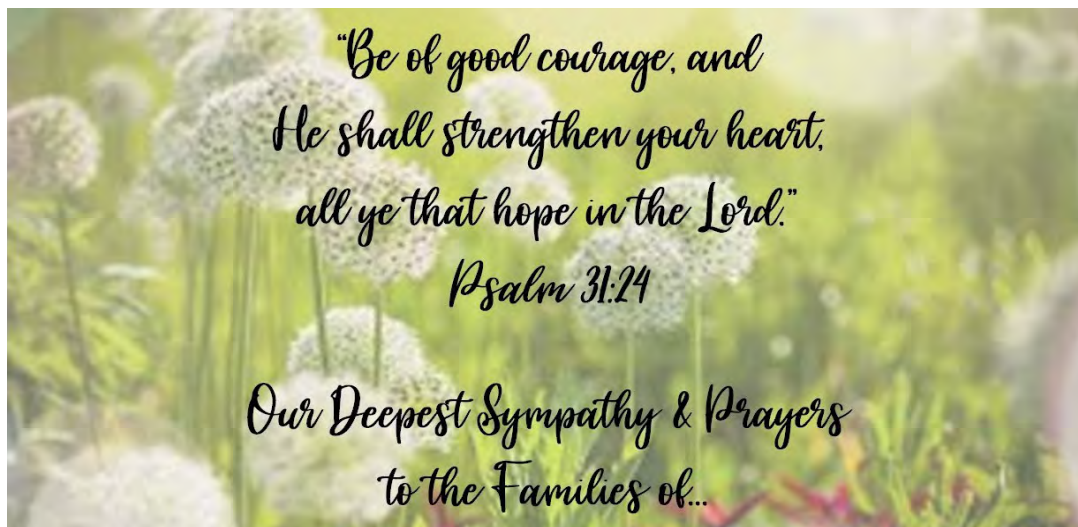

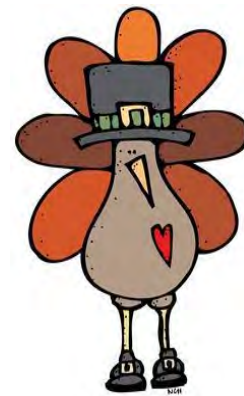
