Weekly Program Notes:

- 1. Children are provided an afternoon snack. If your child has any allergies, please let us know so that we can be sure to monitor snacks for them.
- 2. If your child has any medications that may need to be given during Sing & Celebrate, please make sure the church office/volunteer team is aware prior to drop off.
- 3. Please be sure that backpacks, water bottles, lunch boxes, etc. are labelled. The children will leave their bags in the Assembly Room upon arrival, and we want to make sure that the items they come in with also go home with them. :)
