#### Pastoral Ponderings

"Be strong and courageous; have no fear or dread of them, because it is the LORD your God who goes with you; he will not fail you or forsake you." Deut. 31:6

Yesterday, I watched a speech given by a nun in Australia. During her address she said that there is a rule in her order that nuns aren't supposed to run anywhere. It's a strange rule for a group of nuns to have, but as she explains, the sight of a group of nuns running away from something, can send a horrifying message of fear to all who witness it. She states laughingly, "If you see nuns running, drop what you're doing and run too!"

She goes on to talk more seriously about fear in our daily lives and reminds us that being afraid of things around us is one of the most human and normal experiences that we could possibly have. She stated that there are so many things in our lives that instill fear in us, and its completely understandable to be afraid. However, she goes on to point out, that in the Gospel of John, each time Jesus and the disciples encounter a frightening moment, or something that threatens them, or the people around them, Jesus calls them to trust in Him. The Gospel says that we are to draw close to Him, believe more fully in Him, and to let go of the fear they hold so tightly.

Her homily got me thinking... what are you afraid of right now? What has stopped you in your tracks and kept you from living into the joy and life God has promised you? What are you running from? What do you fear the most right now?

I encourage you and invite you right now to stop reading! Take a few deep breaths, name it out loud, lift it up before God, and confess your fear of who or what is looming over you.

As you come back to this article, I am here to remind you that whatever it is that is bringing you this fear — it is real, it is scary, and no one blames you or thinks less of you for fearing it. It doesn't mean you don't have faith. It doesn't mean that you are not strong or that you are weak in any way. This world is ruthless and mean and dark and scary - that fear is real, you aren't a slave to it

Throughout scripture, one of the most spoken sentences is, "Do not be afraid or do not fear." It's a reminder... an encouragement... a daily prompt and permission that we can actively work to let go of the fear that has overtaken us. In fact, the Bible says those words exactly 365 times. A true daily reminder that every day, we can fight the fear that rises up in us. A daily permission to turn away from the distraction that fear imposes and return back to the loving and safe embrace of God and grace for you. We are called daily, 365 times in scripture, to trust that Christ is here. That He cares deeply about what you are facing. Jesus is sustaining you, strengthening you, and helping you face the fears in your life, so that you might walk with confidence and hope into the new and abundant life Christ offers you.

Do not be afraid, for the Lord is with you. Do not fear, for He will not fail or forsake you. Trust in the Lord always, and know that you are His. Amen

Body: Chair Yoga

Thinking about getting started with exercise but just don't want to get up to get started? Then, try chair yoga. This exercise program offers flexibility and balance exercises that are performed from a chair such as a kitchen table chair.

As with any exercise program, you should take the same safety precautions as any other types of exercises and exercise programs. To safely exercise remember these tips. Make sure to breathe properly. Inhale and exhale with the movement and keep your joints relaxed with the breath. Watch your posture and sit upright. Keep your feet flat on the floor and align your ankles and knees over your feet. Do not strain or perform any movements in a jerking motion. Movements should be slow and smooth. When bending forward, remember to hinge at the hip and not your back. Be careful with spinal twists and do not make extreme twists.

Here are a few yoga poses that can be performed seated in a sturdy chair: hip circles, cat and cow pose, arms overhead side lean, seated Warrior 1 and 2, Figure Four stretch, side twists with arms at the sides, upward plank, forward fold, hamstring forward fold. There are more yoga poses that can be adapted too.


#### Mind:

Breathing and meditation through yoga can help to sharpen the brain and improve mood. Harvard Medical School has studies that show that people that practice yoga regularly process information better and have better cognitive skills. Other studies show that the meditation and relaxation of yoga improves anxiety and depression.




