A brief introduction from Vicar Christine...

Christine Vincent (soon to be Christine Taylor!) will be serving this year as the vicar at Mt. Tabor Lutheran Church. She comes from St. Paul Lutheran Church in Davenport, Iowa. Christine has completed two years of Master of Divinity program at LTSS in Columbia and is starting at Mt. Tabor this month!

In the fall of 2019, Christine began her MDiv degree at LTSS in Columbia, SC. On her first day of seminary, Christine moved into an apartment next door to Isaac Taylor— another LTSS student who was moving in for his first day. Fast forward a couple years, Christine and Isaac will be getting married on October 23rd! Isaac will be finishing his final year of coursework at LTSS while Christine serves at Mt. Tabor.

Christine has been active in the Lutheran church for most of her life. As an adolescent, she found herself feeling at home in her church community. She loved coming on Sunday nights for youth group, volunteered for summer VBS, and went on mission trips. But it wasn't until college that she considered ministry as a career path.

At her alma mater, Augustana College, all incoming freshmen are assigned a "random" academic advisor. Christine's assigned advisor turned out to be head of the pre-seminary program and looking back, she's confident the Holy Spirit was at work here. After being paired with this mentor, Christine found herself learning about seminary and discerning a lifelong call to ministry. She majored in religion with a preseminary focus.

When in college, Christine was introduced to Sky Ranch Lutheran Camp in Fort Collins, Colorado. Christine worked on staff at Sky Ranch for three summers, living in a cabin in the Rocky Mountains. It was here that Christine first experienced the joy that comes with living and working in Christian community. At Sky Ranch, Christine began preaching and leading Bible studies— while continually feeling called toward lifelong ministry.

When Christine isn't working, she enjoys hiking, sitting around campfires with friends, and gardening. Christine is an avid reader and an even more avid napper. She is coming to West Columbia after spending the summer in Knoxville working as a hospital chaplain. Christine is especially looking forward to worship and fellowship with Mt. Tabor this year. She is hopeful for a year full of laughter, grace, learning, and joy with God's people in West Columbia.

Our Love Ministry and Offering for September is Lutheran Campus




